As Ordinary Business:

- To receive the Audited Financial Statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2012 together with the Directors' and Auditors Report thereon.
- To approve the payment of a final single tier dividend of 4.5 sen per ordinary share of RM0.25 each in respect of the financial year ended 31 March 2012.
- To re-elect the following Directors who retire in accordance with Article No. 97 of the Company's Articles of Association:

- To approve the Directors' fees for the financial year ended 31 March 2012.
- To re-appoint Messrs. KPMG as the auditors of the Company and to authorise the Directors to fix their remuneration

As Special Business:

To consider and if thought fit, pass the following resolutions:-

- To re-appoint YM Tengku Dato' Zainal Rashid Bin Tengku Mahmood pursuant to Section 129(6) of the Companies Act, 1965 to hold office until the next annual general meeting of the Company.
- Authority to Directors to allot and issue shares pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965

"THAT pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965, and subject to the approval of all relevant authorities being obtained, the Directors be and are hereby empowered to issue shares in the Company at any time and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may, in their absolute discretion deem fit, provided that the aggregate number of shares issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 10% of shares issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 10% of the issued capital of the Company for the time being and that the Directors be and are also empowered to obtain the approval for the listing of and quotation for the additional shares so issued on the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and that such authority shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company."

Proposed Renewal of Share Buy Back Authority

"THAT approval be and is hereby given to the Company to, from time to time, purchase through Bursa Securities such number of ordinary shares of RM0.25 each in the Company ("Shares") and/or retain such Shares so purchased as treasury shares ("Treasury Shares") as may be determined by the Directors of the Company upon such terms and conditions as the Directors may deem fit and expedient in the best interests of the Company provided that the aggregate number of Shares purchased and/or retained as Treasury Shares shall not exceed ten percent (10%) retained as Treasury Shares shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company at the time of purchase ("Proposed Share Buy Back");

THAT the maximum amount of funds to be utilised for the purpose of the Proposed Share Buy Back shall not exceed the Company's aggregate retained profits and share premium account;

THAT upon the purchase by the Company of its own Shares, the Directors of the Company be and are hereby authorised to:-

- cancel all or part of the Shares so purchased; and/or
- retain all or part of the Shares so purchased as Treasury (b) Shares; and/or
- distribute the Treasury Shares as share dividends to the Company's shareholders for the time being and/or to resell the Treasury Shares on Bursa Securities;

THAT such authority from shareholders of the Company will be effective immediately upon passing of this ordinary resolution and will continue to be in force until:-

- the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company at which time the authority shall lapse unless by ordinary resolution passed at that meeting the authority is renewed either unconditionally or subject to conditions; or
- the expiration of the period within which the next AGM is required by law to be held; or
- (iii) revoked or varied by ordinary resolution passed by the shareholders of the Company in a general meeting;

whichever occurs first, but not so as to prejudice the completion of purchase(s) by the Company before the aforesaid expiry date and in any event, in accordance with the provisions of the guidelines issued by Bursa Securities or any other relevant authority;

AND THAT authority be and is hereby given to the Directors of the Company to take all such steps as are necessary, including the opening and maintaining of a central depositories account(s) and entering into all other agreements, arrangements and guarantees with any party or parties to implement, finalise and give full effect to and to implement the Proposed Share Buy Back with full powers to assent to any conditions, modifications, revaluations, variations and/ or amendments (if any) as may be required or imposed by the relevant authorities from time to time and to do all such acts and things as the Directors may deem fit and expedient in the best interest of the Company."

Proposed Renewal of Shareholders' Mandate for Recurrent Related Party Transactions of a Revenue or Trading Nature ("Proposed Renewal of RRPT Mandate")

"THAT approval be and is hereby given to the Company and its subsidiaries to renew the shareholders' mandate for the recurrent related party transactions of a revenue or trading nature as set out in Section 2.2.4 of the Circular to Shareholders dated 31 July 2012 with the related parties described therein which are necessary for the Group's day to day operations, carried out in the normal course of business, at arm's length, on normal commercial terms, not more favourable to the related parties than those generally available to the public and are not detriment of the minority shareholders;

- A member of the Company entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting may appoint up to two proxies to attend and vote in his place. Where a member appoints two proxies, he shall specify the proportion of his shareholdings to be represented by each proxy. A proxy may but need not be a member of the Company and paragraphs (a) and (b) of Section 149(1) of the Companies Act. 1965 shall not apply
- Where a member of the Company is an exempt authorised nominee as defined under the Securities Industry (Central Depository) Act, 1991 which holds ordinary shares in the Company for multiple beneficial owners in one securities account ("omnibus account"), there is no limit to the number of proxies which the exempt authorised nominee may appoint in respect of each omnibus account it holds
- Only members whose name appears on the Register of Depositors as at 13 August 2012 shall be entitled to attend the said meeting or appoint proxy(ies) to attend and/or vote on his behalf.
- The instrument appointing a proxy must be deposited at the Registered Office of the Company at No. 16A, Jalan Astaka U8/83, Bukit Jelutong, 40150 Shah Alam, Selangor Darul Ehsan, at least 48 hours before the appointed time of holding the Meeting.
- In the case of a corporation, the instrument appointing a proxy or proxies must be under seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised.

Ordinary Resolution 8

The re-appointment of YM Tengku Dato' Zainal Rashid Bin Tengku Mahmood, a person over the age of seventy (70) years as Director of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next AGM of the Company shall take effect if the proposed Ordinary Resolution 8 has been passed by a majority of not less than three-fourths (3/4) of such members as being entitled to vote in person or, where proxies are allowed, by proxy, at the 15th AGM.

Ordinary Resolution 9

The proposed resolution is a renewal of the general authority for the Directors to issue shares pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965. If passed will empower the Directors from the date of the above Annual General Meeting until the next Annual General Meeting to allot and issue shares in the Company up to an amount not exceeding in total 10% of the issued share capital of the Company for the time being for such purposes as the Directors consider would be in the interests of the Company. This authority, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the next Annual General Meeting.

The Company has allotted and issued new 1,798 ordinary shares of RM0.25 each at an price of RM3.30 each arising from the conversion of warrants under the general authority was approved at the 14th Annual General Meeting held on 23 August 2011.

The general authority to issue shares will allow the Company to take advantage of any strategic opportunities, including but not limited to, issuance of new shares for purpose of funding investment project(s), working capital and/or acquisitions which require new shares to be allotted and issued. This would avoid any delay and costs in convening a general meeting to specifically approve such an issue of shares

Ordinary Resolution 10

The proposed resolutions, if passed, will empower the Company to purchase and/or hold up to 10% of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company. This authority unless revoked or varied by the Company at a General Meeting will expire at the next Annual General Meeting of the Company. An interested director or interested major shareholder must ensure that persons connected to him abstain from voting on the resolutions approving the transactions
