NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eighty-eighth Annual General Meeting of GuocoLand (Malaysia) Berhad (the "Company") will be held at the Theatrette, Level 1, Wisma Hong Leong, 18 Jalan Perak, 50450 Kuala Lumpur on Wednesday, 10 October 2012 at 11.00 a.m. in order:

To lay before the meeting the audited financial statements together with the reports of the Directors and Auditors thereon for the financial year ended 30 June 2012. 1.

- To declare a final dividend of 4% less tax for the financial year ended 30 June 2012 to be paid on 31 October 2012 to members registered in the Record of Depositors on 17 October 2012. (Resolution 1) 2.
- To approve the payment of Director fees of RM430,000 for the financial year ended 30 June 2012 (2011: RM360,000), to be divided amongst the Directors in such manner as the Directors may determine. (Resolution 2) 3
- 4 To re-elect the following retiring Directors: (a) Mr Tan Keok Yin; and
 - (b) YBhg Dato' Ong Joo Theam.
- 5. To pass the following motion as an Ordinary Resolution:
- "THAT YBhg Dato' Chew Kong Seng, a Director who retires in compliance with Section 129 of the Companies Act, 1965, be and is hereby re-appointed as a Director of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting." (Resolution 5)
- To re-appoint Messrs Ernst & Young as Auditors of the Company and authorise the Directors to fix their remuneration. (Resolution 6) 6.

As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass the following motions as Ordinary Resolutions:

"THAT pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965, the Directors be and are hereby empowered to issue shares in the Company, at any time and from time to time, and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may, in their absolute discretion, deem fit, provided that the aggregate number of shares issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 10% of the issued capital of the Company for the time being and that the Directors be and are also empowered to obtain approval for the listing of and quotation for the additional shares so issued on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and that such authority shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company." **(Resolution 7)**

Proposed Shareholders' Mandate On Recurrent Related Party Transactions Of A Revenue Or Trading Nature With Hong Leong Company (Malaysia) Berhad ("HLCM") And Persons Connected With HLCM 8

And Persons Connected with HLCM "THAT approval be and is hereby given for the Company and/or its subsidiaries to enter into any of the transactions falling within the types of recurrent related party transactions of a revenue or trading nature as set out in paragraph 2.3(A) of the Company's Circular to Shareholders dated 18 September 2012, with HLCM and persons connected with HLCM provided that such transactions are undertaken in the ordinary course of business, on terms which are not more favourable to the related parties than those generally available to and/or from the public, where applicable, and are not, in the Company's opinion, detrimental to the minority shareholders and that the breakdown of the aggregate value of the recurrent related party transactions conducted during the financial year, including the types of recurrent transactions made and the names of the related parties involved and their relationship with the Company and/or its subsidiaries, are disclosed in the annual report of the Company;

AND THAT, such approval shall continue to be in force until:

- the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company at which time it will lapse, unless by a resolution passed at the meeting, the authority is renewed; or (i)
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next AGM of the Company after that date is required to be held pursuant to Section 143(1) of the Companies Act, 1965 (but shall not extend to such extension as may be allowed pursuant to Section 143(2) of the Companies Act 1965 (companies) Act, 1965); or

(iii) revoked or varied by resolution passed by the shareholders in general meeting.

AND THAT the Directors of the Company be and are hereby authorised to complete and to do all such acts and things (including executing all such documents as may be required) as they may consider expedient or necessary to give effect to the transactions contemplated and/or authorised by this ordinary resolution." Authority To Dire ctors To Issue Shares

The Renewed Mandate, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company.

As at the date of this Notice, no new shares in the Company were issued pursuant to the mandate granted to the Directors at the I Annual General Meeting held on 11 October 2011 and which will lapse at the conclusion of the Eighty-eighth Annual General Meeting
