Authority to Issue and Allot Shares Pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act. 1965

"That, subject always to the Companies Act, 1965, the Articles of Association of the Company and the approvals of the relevant governmental/regulatory authorities, the Directors be and are hereby empowered, pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965, to issue and allot shares in the Company from time to time and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may deem fit provided that the aggregate number of shares issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 10% of the issued share capital of the Company for the time being and that such authority shall continue to be in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company."

Transactions of a Revenue or Trading Nature
"THAT, subject to the provisions of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad's Main Market Listing Requirements, approval be and is hereby given for the Company and its subsidiary companies, to enter into recurrent related party transactions of a revenue or trading nature with the related parties as specified in Section 2.3 of the Circular to Shareholders dated 14 November 2012 ("Proposed Mandate") which are necessary for the day-to-day operations and/or in the ordinary course of business of the Company and its subsidiary companies on terms not more favourable to the related parties than those generally available to the public and are not detrimental to the minority shareholders of the Company and that such approval shall continue to be in force until: until

- the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company followir AGM at which the ordinary resolution for the Proposed Mandate will be passed, at lapse, unless by a resolution passed at a general meeting, the authority is renewed;
- the expiration of the period within which the next AGM after the date it is required to be held purt to Section 143(1) of the Companies Act, 1965 (but shall not extend to such extension as mallowed pursuant to Section 143(2) of the Companies Act, 1965); or
- revoked or varied by resolution passed by the shareholders at a general meeting; whichever is the earlier.

And Further That authority be and is hereby given to the Directors of the Company and its subsidiary companies to complete and do all such acts and things (including executing such documents as may be required) to give effect to such transactions as authorised by this Ordinary Resolution."

(B) ORDINARY BUSINESS

The auditors, Messrs Ernst & Young, would not be seeking for re-appointment as auditors of the Company at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting ("AGM") and would retire at the conclusion of the AGM.

The Company had received a notice from a shareholder pursuant to Section 172(11) of the Companies Act, 1965, for the nomination of Messrs Deloitte KassimChan who have given their consent to act, for appointment as the auditors of the Company at the forthcoming AGM.

The Directors confirmed that there were no disagreements with Messrs Ernst & Young on any accounting issues during the financial year ended 30 June 2012 and there were no other circumstances connected with the change of auditors that should be brought to the attention of the shareholders.

SPECIAL BUSINESS

Resolution 12 is proposed for the purpose of granting a renewed general mandate ("General Mandate") and empowering the Directors of the Company, pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965, to issue and allot new shares in the Company from time to time provided that the aggregate number of shares issued pursuant to the General Mandate does not exceed 10% of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company for the time being. The General Mandate, unless revoked or varied by the Company in general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company.

As at the date of this Notice, no new shares in the Company were issued pursuant to the mandate granted to the Directo at the Fifty-First Annual General Meeting held on 22 November 2011 and which will lapse at the conclusion of the Fifty-Secon at the Fifty-First Annual G Annual General Meeting.

The General Mandate will provide flexibility to the Company for any possible fund raising activities, including but not limited to further placing of shares, for purpose of funding future investment project(s), working capital and/or acquisitions. Resolution 13 is in relation to the approval on the Shareholder's Mandate on Recurrent Related Party Transactions and if passed, will allow the Company and its subsidiary companies to enter into Recurrent Related Party Transactions in accordance with paragraph 10.09 of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad's Main Market Listing Requirements.
