NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Thirty-Second Annual General Meeting of the Company will be held at Lumut 1 Room, Level 1, Vistana Hotel, No. 9 Jalan Lumut, Off Jalan Ipoh, 50400 Kuala Lumpur on Monday, 31 March 2014 at 10:00 a.m. to transact the following business:

Ordinary Business

- To receive the Audited Financial Statements for the financial year ended 30 September 2013 and the Reports of the Directors and Auditors thereon. *(Resolution 1)*
- To approve the payment of Directors' fees amounting to RM198,000 for the financial year ended 30 September 2013 (2012 : RM180,000). *(Resolution 2)*
- To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution:
"That Mr. Ng Siow Hwa @ Ng Kok Hwa, who retires in accordance with Section 129 (6) of the Companies Act, 1965, be and is hereby re-appointed as a Director of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting." *(Resolution 3)*
- To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution:
"That Mr. Ng Sing Kun @ Ng Seng Kuan, who retires in accordance with Section 129 (6) of the Companies Act, 1965, be and is hereby re-appointed as a Director of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting." *(Resolution 4)*
- To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution:
"That En. Noordin Bin Mohd. Noor, who retires in accordance with Section 129 (6) of the Companies Act, 1965, be and is hereby re-appointed as a Director of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting." *(Resolution 5)*
- To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution:
"That Mr. Ng Peng Huah, who retires in accordance with Section 129 (6) of the Companies Act, 1965, be and is hereby re-appointed as a Director of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting." *(Resolution 6)*
- To re-elect the following Directors retiring in accordance with Article 101(1) of the Company's Articles of Association:

- To re-appoint Messrs. PCCO PLT (formerly known as Paul Chuah & Co. PLT) as Auditors of the Company and to authorise the Directors to fix their remuneration. *(Resolution 9)*

Special Business

- Ordinary Resolution - Proposed Shareholder Mandate for Recurrent Related Party Transactions of a Revenue or Trading Nature which are in the Ordinary Course of Business**

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following, with or without modifications, as an ordinary resolution:

"THAT, subject to the Companies Act, 1965 ("Act"), the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad, approval be and is hereby given to UMS and/or its subsidiaries to enter into any of the category of recurrent related party transactions of a revenue or trading nature as set out in Part A, Section 2.3 of the Circular to Shareholders of the Company dated 7 March 2014 ("the Circular") with the related parties mentioned therein which are necessary for UMS Group's day-to-day operations subject further to the following:-

- the transactions are in the ordinary course of business and are on normal commercial terms which are not more favourable to the related parties than those generally available to the public; and
- disclosure is made in the annual report of the aggregate value of transactions conducted pursuant to the Proposed Shareholder Mandate during the financial year;

AND THAT such approval shall continue to be in force until :-

- the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company following this Annual General Meeting, at which time it will lapse, unless by a resolution passed at the said AGM, such authority is renewed;
- the expiration of the period within which the next AGM of the Company is required to be held pursuant to Section 143(1) of the Act (but shall not extend to such extension as may be allowed pursuant to Section 143(2) of the Act); or
- revoked or varied by resolution passed by the shareholders in a general meeting; whichever is the earlier;

AND THAT authority be and is hereby given to the Board to take all such steps as necessary to implement, finalise and give full effect to and to implement the Proposed Shareholder Mandate for Recurrent Related Party Transactions with full powers to assent to any conditions, modifications, revaluations, variations and/or amendments (if any) as may be required or imposed by the relevant authorities from time to time and to do all such acts and things as the Board may deem fit and expedient in the best interest of the Company." *(Resolution 10)*

- Ordinary Resolution - Proposed Share Buy-Back**

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following, with or without modifications, as an ordinary resolution:

"THAT, subject to the Companies Act, 1965, the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, the Main Market Listing Requirements ("Listing Requirements") of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") and the approval of such relevant government and/or regulatory authorities where necessary, the Company be and is hereby authorized to purchase its own ordinary shares ("Shares") on Bursa Securities ("Proposed Share Buy-Back") at any time, upon such terms and conditions as the Directors shall in their discretion deem fit and expedient in the best interest of the Company provided that:-

- The aggregate number of Shares in the Company which may be purchased and/or held by the Company shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the prevailing issued and paid-up share capital of the Company at the time of purchase and the compliance with the public shareholding spread requirements as stipulated in Paragraph 8.02(1) of the Listing Requirements or such other requirements as may be determined by Bursa Securities from time to time;
- The maximum funds to be allocated by the Company for the purpose of purchasing the Shares shall not exceed the Company's latest audited retained profits and/or share premium accounts of the Company of RM802,761 and RM1,843,740 respectively as at 30 September 2013;
- The authority conferred by this resolution will commence after the passing of this ordinary resolution and will continue to be in force until:-
 - the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") at which time it shall lapse unless by ordinary resolution passed at the meeting, the authority is renewed, either unconditionally or subject to conditions; or
 - the expiration of the period within which the next AGM after that date is required by law to be held; or

- revoked or varied by ordinary resolution passed by the shareholders of the Company in a general meeting;

whichever occurs first; and

- Upon the purchase by the Company of its own Shares, the Board be and is hereby authorized to:-
 - cancel all or part of the Shares purchased pursuant to the Proposed Share Buy-Back ("Purchased Shares"); and/or
 - retain all or part of the Purchased Shares as Treasury Shares; and/or
 - distribute the Treasury Shares as share dividends to the Company's shareholders for the time being; and/or
 - resell the Treasury Shares on Bursa Securities.

AND that authority be and is hereby given to the Board to take all such steps as necessary to implement, finalise and give full effect to and to implement the Proposed Share Buy-Back with full powers to assent to any conditions, modifications, revaluations, variations and/or amendments (if any) as may be required or imposed by the relevant authorities from time to time and to do all such acts and things as the Board may deem fit and expedient in the best interest of the Company." *(Resolution 11)*

- To transact any other business for which due notice shall have been given.

FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT for the purpose of determining a member who shall be entitled to attend this Thirty-Second Annual General Meeting, the Company shall be requesting Bursa Malaysia Depository Sdn. Bhd. ("Bursa Depository") in accordance with Article 67 (3) of the Company's Articles of Association and Section 34 (1) of the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act 1991 to issue a General Meeting Record of Depositors as at 24 March 2014. Only a depositor whose name appears on the Record of Depositors as at 24 March 2014 shall be entitled to attend the said meeting or appoint proxy/proxies to attend and/or vote on his behalf.

NOTES:

- A proxy may but need not be a member of the Company and the provisions of Section 149(1)(b) of the Act shall not apply to the Company.
- A member shall be entitled to appoint more than one (1) proxy to attend and vote at the same meeting. Where a member appoints more than one (1) proxy, the appointment shall be invalid unless he specifies the proportions of his holdings to be represented by each proxy. If the appointor is a corporation, this form must be executed under its Common Seal or under the hand of its attorney.
- The instrument appointing a proxy must be deposited at the Company's Registered Office at 3rd Floor, No. 17 Jalan Ipoh Kecil, 50350 Kuala Lumpur not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting or any adjournment thereof.

EXPLANATORY NOTES ON SPECIAL BUSINESS

- Proposed Shareholder Mandate for Recurrent Related Party Transactions of a Revenue or Trading Nature which are in the Ordinary Course of Business**

The Ordinary Resolution, if approved, will authorise UMS Group to enter into any of the category of recurrent related party transactions of a revenue or trading nature as set out in Section 2.3 of the Circular to Shareholders of the Company dated 7 March 2014 ("the Circular") provided that such transactions are in the ordinary course of business and are on normal commercial terms which are not more favourable to the related parties than those generally available to the public and disclosure is made in the annual report of the aggregate value of transactions conducted pursuant to the Proposed Shareholder Mandate during the financial year. This authority, unless revoked or varied by the Company at a general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company or will subsist until the expiration of the period within which the next AGM of the Company is required by law to be held, whichever is the earlier.

- Proposed Share Buy-Back**

The Ordinary Resolution, if passed, will provide mandate for the Company to buy-back its own shares up to a limit of 10% of the existing issued and paid-up share capital of the Company. Further explanatory notes on Resolution 11 is set out in the Statement to Shareholders dated 7 March 2014 despatched together with the Annual Report.

- Retention of Independent Directors**

The Board of Directors has vide the Nomination Committee conducted an assessment of independence of the following directors who have served as Independent Non-Executive Directors of a cumulative term of more than nine years and recommended them to continue to act as Independent Non-Executive Directors based on the following justifications :

- En. Noordin Bin Mohd Noor
- Mr. Ng Peng Huah
- Mr. Lee Kok Wei

Justifications

- They have met the independence guidelines as set out in Chapter 1 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Main Market Listing Requirements and are therefore able to give independent opinion to the Board;
- Being directors for more than nine years have enabled them to contribute positively during deliberations/discussions at meetings as they are familiar with the operations of the Company and possess knowledge of the Company's operations;
- They have contributed sufficient time and exercised due care during their tenure as Independent Non-Executive Directors;
- They have discharged their professional duties in good faith and also in the best interest of the Company and shareholders;
- They have the calibre, qualifications, experiences and personal qualities to challenge management in an effective and constructive manner; and
- They have never compromised on their independent judgement.
