# Appointment of Proxy

- A member of the Company entitled to attend and vote at the meeting is entitled to appoint more than one proxy to attend and vote in his stead and such a proxy need not be a member of the Company and the provisions of Section 149(1)(b) of the Companies Act, 1965 shall not apply to the Company. Where a member appoints more than one proxy, the appointment shall be invalid unless he specifies the proportions of his holdings to be represented by each proxy.
- where a member is an authorised nominee as defined under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act, 1991, it may appoint at least one proxy in respect of each securities account it holds with ordinary shares of the Company standing to the credit of the said securities account. The appointment of two or more proxies in respect of each securities account shall be invalid unless the authorised nominee specifies the proportion of its shareholding to be represented by each proxy. 2.
- autions on infines specifies the proportion of its statemoraing to be represented by each proxy. Where a member is an exempt authorised nominee which holds ordinary shares in the Company for multiple beneficial owners in one securities account ("Omnibus Account"), there is no limit to the number of proxies which the exempt authorised nominee may appoint in respect of each Omnibus Account it holds. The appointment of two or more proxies in respect of each Omnibus Account shall be invalid unless the exempt authorised nominee specifies the proportion of its shareholding to be represented by each proxy. 3.

Authority to allot shares under Section 132D (Resolution 5) The proposed Ordinary Resolution, if passed, will give a renewed mandate to the Directors of the Company, from the date of the forthcoming Annual General Meeting (AGM), to allot and issue ordinary shares from the unissued capital of the Company pursuant to Section 132D of the Companies Act, 1965.

As of the date of the Notice, no new shares in the Company were issued pursuant to the mandate granted to the Directors at the last AGM held on 25 June 2014, which will lapse at the conclusion of the forthcoming AGM.

The proposed Ordinary Resolution, if passed, will empower the Directors to issue shares up to an aggregate amount not exceeding 10% of the issued share capital of the Company for the time being, for such purposes as the Directors consider would be in the best interest of the Company.

The authority will provide flexibility to the Company for any possible fund raising activities, including but not limited to placement of shares, funding future investment project(s), working capital and/or acquisitions.
