"THAT subject to Section 132D of the Act, the Company's Articles of Association and the approvals of the relevant authorities, where necessary, the Directors be and are hereby authorised to issue and allot shares in the Company, at any time and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may in their absolute discretion deem fit, provided that the aggregate number of shares to be issued and allotted pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 10% of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company for the time being AND THAT such authority shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company."

- 1. A member of the Company who is entitled to attend and vote at the meeting is entitled to appoint a proxy or more than one proxy to attend and vote in his/her behalf. A proxy may but need not be a member of the Company.
- Where a member appoints more than one proxy, the appointments shall be invalid unless he/she specifies the proportions of his/her holdings to be represented by each proxy.
- Where a member is an exempt authorised nominee as defined under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act 1991, who holds ordinary shares in the company for multiple beneficial owners in one securities account ("Omnibus account"), there is no limit to the number of proxies which the exempt authorised nominee may appoint in respect of each Omnibus account it holds.
- The instrument appointing a proxy shall be in writing under the hands of the appointor or his/her attorney duly authorised in writing or, if the appointor is a corporation, either under its common seal or under the hand of its officer or its attorney duly authorised. If no name is inserted in the space for the name of the proxy, the Chairman of the meeting will act as your proxy.
- The instrument appointing a proxy must be completed and deposited at the office of the Share Registrar of the Company, Symphony Share Registrars Sdn Bhd at Level 6, Symphony House, Pusat Dagangan Dana 1, Jalan PJU1A/46, 47301 Petaling Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan, Malaysia not less than forty-eight (48) hours before the time set for holding the 31st Annual General Meeting or at any adjournment thereof.
- The lodging of a completed Form of Proxy to the Share Registrar of the Company will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the meeting should you subsequently wish to do so. Should you subsequently decide to attend and vote in person at the meeting, you are requested to rescind your earlier appointment of proxy(ies), and notify the Share Registrar of the Company as soon as practicable.
- For the purpose of determining a member who shall be entitled to attend this 31st Annual General Meeting, the Company shall be requesting Bursa Malaysia Depository Sdn Bhd in accordance with Article 57 of the Company's Articles of Association and Section 34(1) of the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act, 1991, to issue a General Meeting Record of Depositors as at 1 September 2015. Only a depositor whose ame appears on the General Meeting Record of Depositors as at 1 September 2015. Unly a depositor whose name appears on the General Meeting Record of Depositors as at 1 September 2015 shall be entitled to attend the said meeting or appoint proxies to attend and/or vote on his or its behalf.

Audited Financial Statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2015 and the Reports of the Directors and Auditors thereon

The audited financial statements under this agenda are laid before the shareholders for discussion only as under the provision of Section 169(1) and (3) of the Act, the audited financial statements do not require a formal approval of the shareholders and hence, this agenda is not put forward for voting

- Abstention from voting The interested Directors of the Company who are shareholders of the Company will abstain from voting on the relevant resolutions in respect of their re-election as the Director of the Company at the 31st Annual General Meeting.
- All the Non-Executive Directors of the Company who are shareholders of the Com pany will abstain from voting on Ordinary Resolution 3 concerning remuneration to the Non-Executive Directors at the 31st Annual General Meeting.

Explanatory notes on Special Business:

11. Ordinary Resolution 5 - Authority to Issue and Allot Shares pursuant to Section 132D of the Act

The ordinary resolution 5 above is proposed for the purpose of granting a renewed general mandate for issuance and allotment of shares by the Company under Section 132D of the Act, and if passed, will give the Directors the authority, from the date of the above Annual General Meeting, to issue and allot shares in the Company at any time up to an aggregate amount not exceeding 10% of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company for such purposes as the Directors may deem fit and in the interest of the Company ("Share Mandate") without convening a General Meeting, which may delay the capital raising initiatives and incur relevant costs in organising the required General Meeting.

The Company has not issued any new shares pursuant to Section 132D of the Act under the general authority which was approved at the 30th Annual General Meeting held on 23 September 2014 and which will lapse at the conclusion of the forthcoming 31st Annual General Meeting.

This Share Mandate, unless revoked or varied at a General Meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company. With this Share Mandate, the Company will have the flexibility to undertake any possible fund raising activities, including but not limited to further placing of shares, for the purpose of funding future investment project(s), working capital and/or acquisition(s).

 - (iii) agreed that the member will indemnify the Company in respect of any penalties, liabilities, claims, demands, losses and damages as a result of the member's breach of the Warranty.
