THAT the mandate given by the shareholders of the Company shall only continue to be in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company or the expiry of the period within which the next Annual General Meeting is required to be held pursuant to Section 143(1) of the Companies Act, 1965 (the Act) (but shall not extend to such extension as may be allowed pursuant to Section 143(2) of the Act); unless revoked or varied by Ordinary Resolution of the shareholders of the Company in general meeting, whichever is the earlier;

AND THAT the Directors of the Company be authorised to complete and carry out such acts and actions as they may consider expedient or necessary to give effect to the shareholders'

PROPOSED RENEWAL OF AUTHORITY FOR THE COMPANY TO PURCHASE ITS OWN SHARES

Resolution 10

"THAT, subject to the provisions of the Companies Act, 1965, Part IIIA of the Companies Regulations 1966, the Articles of Association of the Company, the Main Market Listing Requirements of Brush Malaysis Securities Berhard (Bursa Securities) and any applicable laws, rules, orders, requirements, requirements, requirements or being in force or as may be amended, modified or re-enacted from time to time and the approvals of all relevant governmental and/or regulatory authorities (if any), the Company be and is hereby authorised to purchase such number of ordinary shares of RM0.50 each in the Company as may be determined by the Directors of the Company from time to time through Bursa Securities upon such terms and conditions as the Directors of the Company may deem fit, necessary and expedient in the interest of the Company provided that the aggregates purchased pursuant to this resolution shall not exceed 10% of the total issued and paid-up share capital of the Company at any point in time (Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back Authority); and that the Directors of the Company shall allocate an amount of funds which will not be more than the aggregate sum of the retained profits and share premium of the Company for the Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back Authority;

AND THAT upon completion of the purchase(s) by the Company of its own shares, the Directors of the Company are authorised to decide at their discretion to cancel all the shares so purchased and/or retain the shares so purchased as treasury shares of which may be distributed as dividends to shareholders and/or to resell on the open market of Bursa Securities and/or to retain thereof as treasury shares and cancel the remainder; AND THAT the Directors of the Company be and are hereby authorised and empowered to carry out all acts and actions and to take all such steps and to enter into and execute all commitments, transactions, deeds, agreements, arrangements, undertakings, indemnities, transfers, assignments and/or guarantees as they may deem fit, necessary, expedient and/or appropriate in order

to implement, finalise and give full effect to the Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back Authority with full powers to assent to any conditions, modifications, revaluations, variations and/or amendments, as may be required or imposed by any relevant authority or authorities;

AND THAT the Directors of the Company be and are hereby empowered immediately upon the passing of this Ordinary Resolution until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company at which such resolution was passed, at which time the authority shall lapse unless by ordinary resolution passed at a general meeting, the authority is renewed either unconditionally or subject to conditions; or the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by law to be held; or the earlier revocation or variation of the authority through a general meeting whichever is the earliest, but not so as to prejudice the completion of purchase(s) by the Company before the aforesaid expiry date."

An exempt authorised nominee refers to an authorised nominee defined under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act 1991 (SICDA) which is exempted from compliance with the provisions of subsection 25A(1) of SICDA.

Such Director will hold the office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting (AGM).
