THAT subject always to the Act, the Constitution of the Company and the approvals of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") and the relevant regulatory authorities where such approval is necessary, the Directors be and are hereby empowered, pursuant to Sections 75 and 76 of the Act, to issue shares of the Company at any time until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may in their absolute discretion deem fit, provided that the aggregate number of shares to be issued does not exceed 10% of the total issued and paid-up share capital of the Company (excluding treasury shares) at the time of issue.

The proposed Ordinary Resolution 5, if passed, will empower the Directors from the conclusion of this AGM, to allot and issue up to a maximum of 10% of the total issued and paid-up share capital of the Company (excluding treasury shares) at the time of issue (other than bonus or rights issue) without the need to convene a general meeting and for such purposes as they consider would be in the best interest of the Company. This authority, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the next AGM of the Company. This mandate will provide issuibility to the Company for any possible tund raising activities, including but not limited to placing of shares, for the purpose of funding working capital, future investment project(s) and/or acquisition(s). At this juncture, there is no decision to issue new shares. If there should be a decision to issue any new share after the general mandate is sought, the Company will make an announcement in respect thereof.

The proposed Ordinary Resolution 5 is a renewal of the general mandate for issuance of shares pursuant to Sections 75 and 76 of the Act.
