PROPOSED RENEWAL OF THE AUTHORITY FOR THE COMPANY TO PURCHASE ITS OWN SHARES

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"THAT, subject to the Companies Act 2016 ("the Act"), the Company's Memorandum and Articles of Association and Bursa Malaysia Securities
Berhad ("Bursa Securities") Main Market Listing Requirements and any other relevant authorities, the Directors of the Company be and are
hereby authorised to make purchases of ordinary shares in the Company's share capital through Bursa Securities and to take all such steps as
are necessary (including the opening and maintaining of a depository account under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act, 1991)
and enter into any agreements, arrangements and guarantees with any party or parties to implement, finalise and give full effect to the aforesaid
purchase with full powers to assent to any conditions, modifications, variations and/or amendments (if any) as may be imposed by the relevant
authorities from time to time and to do all such acts and things as the Directors may deem fit and expedient in the best interests of the Company,
subject further to the following:

the maximum number of ordinary shares which may be purchased and held by the Company shall be equivalent to 10% of the total n of issued shares of the Company at the time of purchase;

the maximum funds to be allocated by the Company for the purpose of purchasing the ordinary shares shall not exceed the total retained profits of the Company;

the approval conferred by this resolution will commence immediately upon the passing of this resolution and will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company following the passing of this resolution (unless earlier revoked or varied by ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Company in a general meeting) but not so as to prejudice the completion of purchase(s) by the Company before the aforesaid expiry date and, in any event, in accordance with the provisions of the Act, the rules and regulations made pursuant thereto and the guidelines issued by Bursa Securities and any other relevant authorities; and

upon completion of the purchase(s) of the ordinary shares or any part thereof by the Company, the Directors of the Company be and are hereby authorised to cancel all the shares so purchased or retain all the shares as treasury shares (of which may be dealt with in accordance with Section 127(7) of the Act) or retain part thereof as treasury shares and cancelling the balance, and in any other manner as prescribed by the Act, rules, regulations and orders made pursuant to the Act and the requirements of Bursa Securities and any other relevant authorities for the time being in force."

This agenda item is meant for discussion only as the provision of Section 340(1)(a) of the Companies Act 2016 does not require a formal approval of the shareholders for the Audited Financial Statements. Hence, this agenda item is not put forward for voting Ordinary Resolution 1 – Directors' Fees

The proposed Ordinary Resolution 1, if passed, will authorise the increase and payment of Directors' fees in respect of the financial year ended 30 June 2017 amounting to RM468,000 (2016: RN424,400). The Board opined that it is just and equitable for the Non-Executive Directors to be paid such payment in view of their increased level of duties and responsibilities, and time commitment required for them to discharge their duties effectively. Ordinary Resolution 6 – Authority to Issue Shares under Section 75 and 76 of the Companies Act 2016

Ordinary Resolution 6 - Authority to issue Shares under Section 75 and 76 of the Companies Act 2016
The proposed Ordinary Resolution 6, if passed is to empower the Directors of the Company to fixue and allot shares up to an amount not exceeding in total 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company for the time being for such purposes as the Directors consider would be in the best interest of the Company. This approval is sought to avoid any delay and costs involved in convening a general meeting of the Company to approve such issue of shares. This authority, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the next Annual General Meeting of the Company.

The general mandate sought for the issue of shares is a renewal to the general mandate which was approved by shareholders at the last Annual General Meeting held on 23 November 2016. As at the date of this notice, the Company has not issued any new shares under this general mandate which will lapse at the conclusion of the 7th Annual General Meeting.

The renewal of the general manadate will provide flexibility to the Company for any possible fund raising activities including but not limited to issuance of new shares for funding investment projects, working capital and/or acquisitions.

Ordinary Resolution 7 — Proposed Renewal of Shareholders' Mandate for Recurrent Related Party Transactions of a Revenue or Trading Nature The proposed Ordinary Resolution 7, if passed, will empower the Company and/or its subsidiary companies to enter into Recurrent Related Party Transactions of a Revenue or Trading Nature in a timely manner. This will substantially reduce administrative time, inconvenience and expenses associated with the convening of general meetings, without compromising the corporate objectives of the Group or adversely affecting the business opportunities available to the Group.

Further information on the Proposed Shareholders' Mandate is set out in the Circular/Statement to Shareholders dated 30 October 2017 which is dispatched together with the Annual Report 2017. Ordinary Resolution 8 – Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back Authority The proposed Ordinary Resolution 8, if passed, will empower the Directors to purchase the Company's shares up to 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company by utilising the funds allocated out of the retained profits of the Company. This authority, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company.

Proxy A member entitled to attend and vote at the meeting is entitled to appoint not more than two (2) proxies to attend and vote in his stead. Where a member appoints more than one (1) proxy, the proxy shall be invalid unless he specifies the

- proportion of his shareholdings to be represented by each proxy Where a member is an exempt authorised nominee as defined under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories). Act, 1991 which holds shares in the Company for multiple beneficial owners in one securities account ('omnibus account'), there is no limit to the number of proxies which the exempt authorised nominee may appoint in respect of each omnibus account it holds.

 A proxy need not be a member of the Company. There shall be no restriction as to the qualification of the proxy.
- In the case of a corporate member, the instrument appointing a proxy shall be under its Common Seal or under the hand of a duly authorised officer or attorner The instrument appointing a proxy must be deposited at the Company's Registered Office situated at No. 45-5, The Boulevard, Mid Valley Gity, Lingkaran Syed Putra, 59200 Kuala Lumpur not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the meeting or at any adjournment thereof.
- If you wish to attend the meeting yourself, please do not submit any Proxy Form for the meeting that you wish to attend. You will not be allowed to attend the meeting together with a proxy appointed by you.
