The Company is seeking shareholders' approval pursuant to Section 230(1) of the Companies Act 2016 for the payment of the Directors' benefits incurred or to be incurred from the date of the 22<sup>nd</sup> AGM until the next annual general meeting of the Company to be held in the year 2020. Authority to Allot and Issue Shares Pursuant to Sections 75 and 76 of the Companies Act 2016

The proposed Ordinary Resolution 7 is primarily to give authority to the Board of Directors to allot and issue up to 10% of the total number of issued shares at any time in their absolute discretion and for such purpose as they consider would be in the best interest of the Company without convening a general meeting. This authority, if granted, is a renewal of the earlier mandate granted at the Twenty First Annual General Meeting of the Company.

Shall expire at the Twenty-Third Annual General Meeting of the Company.

The Company continues to consider opportunities to broaden its earnings potential. If any of the expansion/diversification proposals involves the issue of new shares, the Directors, under certain circumstance when the opportunity arises, would have to convene a general meeting to approve the issue of new shares even though the number involved may be less than 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company.

In order to avoid any delay and costs involved in convening a general meeting to approve such issue of shares when the new ay arise during the financial year, it is thus considered appropriate that the Directors be empowered to issue shares in Company, up to any amount not exceeding in total, 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company for the time be for such purpose.
