Explanatory Notes:

Ordinary Resolutions 1 and 2

Directors' fees and benefits payable to Non-Executive Directors

Pursuant to Section 230(1) of the Companies Act 2016, the fees of the directors and any benefits payable to the directors of a listed company and its subsidiarie shall be approved at a general meeting. In this respect, the Board of Directors ("Board") agreed that the members' approval shall be sought at the 28th AG on the Directors' fees and benefits in two (2) resolutions as follows: AGM

- Ordinary Resolution 1 on payment of Directors' fees from 8 June 2023 until the next AGM
- The total amount of Directors' fees payable to the Non-Executive Directors from 8 June 2023 until the next AGM tabled for the members' approval is RM168,000. The figure is calculated with the assumption that there is no adjustment to the Directors' fees and no change in the Board size during the aforesaid period.
- Ordinary Resolution 2 on payment of Directors' benefits from 8 June 2023 until the next AGM The Directors' benefits are essentially meeting allowance to Non-Executive Directors for attendance of meetings of the Board, Board Committees and general meetings, allowance to Senior Independent Director, and allowances to Independent Directors for participation in Board Committees.

The Board will seek shareholders' approval at the next AGM in the event the amount of Directors' fees and benefits is insufficient due to an increase in Board size and/or number of meetings.

Ordinary Resolution 6

Authority to Allot Shares Pursuant to Section 75 of the Companies Act 2016

The proposed Ordinary Resolution 6 if passed, will:

- empower the Directors of the Company, from the date of the above AGM to allot and issue not more than 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company subject to the approvals of all the relevant governmental and/or other regulatory bodies and for such purposes as the Directors consider would be in the interest of the Company; and a)
- give direction to the Directors of the Company to offer and issue new shares pursuant to the authority granted under Ordinary Resolution 6 to any such persons without first to offer the new shares to the existing members of the Company in proportion to their shareholding. b)

The authorisation, unless revoked or varied by the Company in general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next AGM of the Company.

The authority will provide flexibility to the Company for the purpose of funding future investment projects, working capital and/or acquisition, or strategic opportunities involving equity deals, which may require the allotment of new shares. In addition, any delay arising from and cost involved in convening an Extraordinary General Meeting to approve such issuance of shares should be eliminated.

As at the date of printing of the Annual Report, no new share was issued by the Company pursuant to the authority granted to the Directors at the 27th AGM held on 2 June 2022 and the said authority will lapse at the conclusion of the 28th AGM.
