

NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **THIRTY-FIFTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING** of the Company ("35th AGM") will be held at the Registered Office of the Company at Lot 6, Block 44, Leboh Tiga, 90000 Sandakan, Sabah on **Monday, 19 June 2023 at 10.00 a.m.** to transact the following businesses: -

AS ORDINARY BUSINESS

- 1. To receive the Audited Financial Statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2022 and the Reports of the Directors and Auditors thereon. *[Refer to Explanatory Note A]*
- 2. To re-elect Mr Ho Sui Ting, who retires as a Director by rotation pursuant to Article 79 of the Company's Constitution. [Refer to Explanatory Note B] Ordinary Resolution 1
- 3. To re-elect Mr Lee Chi Min, who retires as a Director pursuant to Article 84 of the Company's Constitution. [Refer to Explanatory Note C] Ordinary Resolution 2
- 4. To re-elect Mr Lim Shaw Keong @ Alfred Lim, who retires as a Director pursuant to Article 84 of the Company's Constitution. [Refer to Explanatory Note C] Ordinary Resolution 3
- 5. To re-elect Madam Wong Lee Hung, who retires as a Director pursuant to Article 84 of the Company's Constitution. [Refer to Explanatory Note C] Ordinary Resolution 4
- 6. To approve the payment of Directors' fees of RM32,500.00 for the financial year ended 31 December 2022.

Ordinary Resolution 7

AS SPECIAL BUSINESS, to consider and if thought fit, to pass the following Resolutions:

 Authority For Directors To Issue And Allot Shares Pursuant To Sections 75 & 76 Of The Companies Act 2016

"THAT subject always to the Companies Act 2016 ("Act"), the Constitution of the Company and the approvals of the relevant governmental/regulatory authorities, the Directors be and are hereby empowered, pursuant to Sections 75 & 76 of the Act, to issue shares in the Company from time to time to such parties and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may deem fit provided that the aggregate number of shares issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company at the time of the passing of this resolution, that the Directors be and are also empowered to obtain approval from Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the listing of and quotation for additional shares so issued and that such authority shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company".

Ordinary Resolution 8

10. Proposed Renewal Of The Existing Shareholders' Mandate For Recurrent Related Party Transactions Of A Revenue Or Trading Nature

"THAT subject to compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and guidelines, a mandate be and is hereby given to the Company and its subsidiaries to enter into recurrent transactions of a revenue or trading nature with related parties as set out in the Circular to Shareholders dated 19 May 2023, which are necessary for the day-to-day operations and not more favourable to the related parties than those generally available to the public and are not to the detriment of the minority shareholders and that authority conferred by this resolution shall commence immediately upon the passing of this resolution;

AND THAT such mandate shall continue in force until: -

- (a) the conclusion of the next AGM of the Company, at which time it will lapse, unless by a resolution passed at that meeting, the authority is renewed;
- (b) the expiration of the period within which the next AGM after the date it is required to be held pursuant to Section 340(2) of the Act, [but shall not extend to such extension as may be allowed pursuant to Section 340(4) of the Act]; or

whichever is the earlier.

AND THAT the breakdown of the aggregate value of the recurrent related party transactions made during the financial year will be disclosed in the Company's Annual Report based on the following information:-

- (a) the type of the recurrent related party transactions made; and

11. Proposed Renewal Of Authority For The Purchase By The Company Of Its Own Ordinary Shares

"THAT, subject to the Act, the Constitution of the Company, the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") ("Listing Requirements") and the approval of such relevant governmental and/or regulatory authorities, the Board of Directors of the Company ("Board") be and is hereby unconditionally and generally authorised, to the extent permitted by law, to purchase such number of ordinary shares of KHB on the Main Market of Bursa Securities ("Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back") at any time through Bursa Securities, upon such terms and conditions as the Board shall in its discretion deem fit and expedient in the best interest of the Company provided that:

- (a) the aggregate number of ordinary shares which may be purchased and/or held by the Company shall not exceed one percent (1%) of the total number of issued shares of the Company at any point in time; and
- (b) the maximum amount of funds to be allocated by the Company for the Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back shall not exceed the retained profits of the Company at the time of purchase by the Company of its own ordinary shares.

THAT upon the purchase by the Company of the ordinary shares, the Board shall have the absolute discretion to decide whether such shares purchased are to be cancelled and/or retained as treasury shares and distributed as dividends or resold on the Main Market of Bursa Securities or transferred for the purpose of any employees' share scheme which the Company may establish in the future or any other manner as may be prescribed by the Act, rules, regulations and orders made pursuant to the Act, the Listing Requirements and any other relevant authority for the time being in force.

THAT such authority conferred by this resolution will commence immediately upon the passing of this resolution and may only continue to be in force until:

- the conclusion of the next AGM of the Company, at which time the authority will lapse unless by an ordinary resolution passed at that meeting, the authority is renewed, either unconditionally or subject to conditions;
- (b) the expiration of the period within which the next AGM of the Company is required by law to be held; or
- (c) revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution passed by the shareholders in a general meeting,

whichever is the earlier but not as to prejudice the completion of purchase by the Company before the aforesaid expiry date and, in any event, in accordance with the provisions of the Act, the rules and regulations made pursuant thereto and the Listing Requirements and/or any other authorities.

AND THAT authority be and is hereby unconditionally and generally given to the Board to take all such steps that are necessary and expedient (including without limitation, the opening and maintaining of central depository accounts under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act 1991, and the entering into of all agreements, arrangements and guarantees with any party or parties) to implement, finalize and give full effect to the Proposed Renewal of Share Buy-Back with full powers to assent to any conditions, modifications, revaluations, variations and/or amendments (if any) as may be imposed by the relevant authorities and with full power to do all such acts and things thereafter on any part of the shares bought-back in accordance with the Act, the provisions of the Constitution of the Company, the Listing Requirements and all other relevant governmental and/or regulatory authorities."

Explanatory Note B: Proposed Ordinary Resolution 1

The Nomination Committee ("NC") had conducted an annual assessment on the performance, effectiveness and contribution of the Board, Board Committees and individual Directors, the results of which were found to be satisfactory. The Board supports the NC's recommendation on the re-election of Mr Ho Sui Ting as a Director of the Company at the forthcoming 35th AGM as he has the relevant experience and knowledge of the Group's businesses which will bring benefits to the Company.

Explanatory Note C: Proposed Ordinary Resolutions 2, 3 and 4

Mr Lee Chi Min, appointed as a Director of the Company on 1 October 2022, Mr Lim Shaw Keong @ Alfred Lim and Madam Wong Lee Hung appointed as Directors of the Company on 31 December 2022, all retire as Directors pursuant to Article 84 of the Company's Constitution and, being eligible, have offered themselves for re-election.

Explanatory Note D: Proposed Ordinary Resolution 6

The Directors' remuneration (excluding Directors' Fees) is in respect of allowances and other emoluments payable to the Independent Non-Executive Directors. The estimated amount of RM200,000 is for a period of 12 months from the conclusion of the 35th AGM to the next AGM.

Explanatory Note E: Proposed Ordinary Resolution 7

Messrs Ernst & Young PLT have indicated that they do not wish to seek for re-appointment as auditors of the Company at the forthcoming 35th AGM of the Company. Accordingly, the term of office of Messrs Ernst & Young PLT shall end upon the conclusion of the 35th AGM of the Company. The Board wishes to seek shareholders' approval for the appointment of Messrs PKF PLT as auditors of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next AGM in 2024.

The Audit Committee and the Board have considered the proposed appointment of Messrs PKF PLT as auditors of the Company and collectively agreed that Messrs PKF PLT have met the relevant criteria prescribed under Paragraph 15.21 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

Explanatory Note F: Proposed Ordinary Resolution 8

The proposed Ordinary Resolution 8, if passed, will empower the Directors to issue shares up to an aggregate amount not exceeding 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company for the time being, for such purposes as the Directors consider would be in the interest of the Company. This mandate is a renewal of the last mandate granted to the Directors at the 34th AGM held on 15 June 2022 and, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next AGM. The renewal of this mandate will provide flexibility to the Company for any possible fund-raising activities, including but not limited to further placing of shares, for purpose of funding investment project(s), working capital and/or acquisitions.

As at the date of this notice, no new shares in the Company were issued pursuant to the last mandate.
