ORDINARY RESOLUTION - AUTHORITY TO ALLOT AND ISSUE SHARES PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 75 & 76 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2016

"THAT subject to the Companies Act, 2016, the Constitution of the Company and the approvals of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and other relevant governmental and/or regulatory authorities, where such approval is required, the Directors of the Company be and are hereby authorised and empowered pursuant to Sections 75 & 76 of the Companies Act, 2016 to allot and issue shares in the Company from time to time and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes as the Directors may in their absolute discretion deem fit, provided that the aggregate number of shares issued pursuant to this resolution does not exceed ten per centum (10%) of the total issued share capital of the Company for the time being and THAT the Directors be and are also empowered to obtain the approval for the listing of and quotation for the additional shares so issued on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and THAT such authority shall continue to be in force until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company."

THAT pursuant to Section 85 of the Companies Act 2016, read together with Clause 5 of the Constitution of the Company, approval be and is hereby given to waive the statutory pre-emptive rights of the shareholders of the Company to be offered new shares ranking equally to the existing issued shares of the Company arising from any issuance of new shares pursuant to Sections 75 & 76 of the Companies Act, 2016.

 The instrument appointing a proxy in the case of an individual shall be signed by the appointor or his/her attorney or in the case of a corporation executed under its common seal or signed on behalf of the corporation by its attorney duly authorised.

 Where a member of the Company is an exempt authorised nominee which holds ordinary shares in the Company for multiple beneficial owners in one securities account ("Omnibus Account") as defined under the Securities Industry (Central Depositories) Act, 1991, there is no limit to the number of proxies which the exempt authorised nominee may appoint in respect of each Omnibus Account it holds.

Resolution 6
Ordinary Resolution - Authority to allot and issue shares pursuant to Sections 75 & 76 of the Companies Act, 2016
The proposed Ordinary Resolution 6 is a renewable mandate for the issue of shares under Sections 75 & 76 of the Companies Act, 2016. If passed, will give flexibility to the Directors of the Company to issue shares up to a maximum of ten per centum (10%) of the issued share capital of the Company at the time of such issuance of shares (other than bonus or rights issue) and for such purposes as they consider would be in the best interests of the Company without having to convene separate general meetings. This authority, unless revoked or varied at a general meeting, will expire at the conclusion of the next AGM of the Company. THAT pursuant to Section 85 of the Companies Act, 2016, read together with Clause 5 of the Constitution of the Company, approval be and is hereby given to waive the statutory pre-emptive rights of the shareholders of the Company requally to the existing issued shares of the Company arising from any issuance of new shares pursuant to Sections 75 & 76 of the Companies Act, 2016.

No shares have been issued and allotted by the Company since obtaining the said authority from its shareholders at the last AGM held on 16th November 2023 pursuant to this authority. The general mandate will provide flexibility to the Company for any possible fund-raising activities, including but not limited to the placing of shares, funding future invertment(s), acquisition(s) and working capital and thereby reducing administrative time and cost associated with the convening of such meeting(s).
