Q4 has seen the launch of the iMedic cloud based medical tracking system. The initial interest is very high and this product will be developed further to mature into a full blown cloud based medical system.

Palette has also commenced work on an innovative upgrade of a major consumer service within Malaysia with the aim of building a series of mobile apps and software as a service offering that are cloud based. This is expected to impact revenue positively within Q4 and has good long term prospects; this service is built on the expertise gained building Palette's own AMS network product.

Palette continues to build very strong software and network integration capabilities around cloud technologies.
