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# QUARTERLY REPORT ON CONSOLIDATED RESULTS FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2016

#### 1. Basis of Preparation

These interim financial statements of the Group are not audited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134 – *Interim Financial Reporting* and the applicable disclosure provisions of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2015 which were prepared under the Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS").

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## 17. Review of Performance

The Group's revenue for the fourth quarter and twelve months financial year ended 31 December 2016 has increased by 23.15% and 8.71% respectively compared to the corresponding periods of the preceding year. The increase in revenue was mainly due to the additional sales generated from the assumption of the IT division of TESCO hypermarket which started operation since April 2016.

The Group has recorded a Profit Before Tax ("PBT") of RM25,000 for the fourth quarter ended 31 December 2016 and a Loss Before Tax ("LBT") of RM450,000 for the twelve months ended 31 December 2016 as compared to Loss Before Tax ("LBT") of RM18,000 and RM484,000 respectively in the corresponding financial periods of the preceding year.

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## 19. Commentary on Prospects

The main challenges for the Group remains unchanged from the previous year with the main reason being the overall reduction in consumers' spending since the introduction of GST (Goods and Services Tax) in April 2015.

The move from consolidating its operation to focus mainly in the hypermarket stores like AEON and TESCO, the closure of non-performing outlets helps to cut down the overall cost, especially rental and is now showing a very good sign of recovery. We are currently in talk with more hypermarket operators to expand the business accordingly.

The online retail business in Malaysia is still very much in its infant stage and as the growth potential is enormous, more human and capital resources will be invested.

With the change in the business direction to focus the operations in hypermarkets, we expect our performance to improve for the next financial year.
