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QUARTERLY REPORT ON CONSOLIDATED RESULTS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER ENDED 31 MARCH 2019

1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2018 which were prepared under the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") and amendments to standards to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities.

These interim financial statements of the Group are not audited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of MFRS 134 – *Interim Financial Reporting* and the applicable disclosure provisions of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2018.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

The accounting policies applied by the Group in these interim consolidated interim financial statements are consistent with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2018, including the adoption of the following newly-issued MFRS for the financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2019:

MFRS 16, Leases

On the adoption of MFRS 16, Group has assessed the estimated impact that the initial application of MFRS 16. Based on the preliminary assessment, the Group does not expect the application of MFRS 16 to have a significant financial impact on its consolidated financial statements. MFRS 16 replaces the guidance in MFRS 117, Leases, IC Interpretation 4, determining whether an Arrangement contains a Lease, IC Interpretation 115, Operating Leases – Incentives and IC Interpretation 127, evaluating the Substance of Transactions Involving the Legal Form of a Lease.

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2. Significant Accounting Policies (cont'd)

MFRS 16, Leases (cont'd)

MFRS 16 introduces a single, on-balance sheet lease accounting model for lessees. A lessee recognises a right-ofuse asset representing its right to use the underlying asset and a lease liability representing its obligations to make lease payments. There are recognition exemptions for short-term leases and leases of low-value items. Lessor accounting remains similar to the current standard which continues to be classified as finance or operating lease.

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17. Review of Performance

The Group's revenue for the three months ended 31 March 2019 dropped by 8.62% as compared to the corresponding period of the preceding year. The decrease in revenue was mainly due to fewer Aeon members' day promotion and other special weekend promotion sales.

The Group has recorded a Loss Before Tax ("LBT") of RM163,000 for the three months ended 31 March 2019 as compared to a Profit Before Tax of RM51,000 in the corresponding financial period of the preceding year. This was mainly due to the lower gross profit margin resulting from the discounts given during the promotional activities to boost sales and the share of losses from an associate company.

18. Material changes in Profit/(Loss) Before Taxation ("PBT/LBT") against preceding quarter

The Group recorded a LBT of RM163,000 for the first quarter ended 31 March 2019 as compared to PBT of RM142,000 in the preceding quarter ended 31 Dec 2018. The drop was mainly due to decrease of revenue and the share of losses from an associate company during the quarter under review.

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19. Commentary on Prospects

Revenue for Quarter 1 2019 was slightly reduced as our retail space in Aeon and Tesco were downsized due to lesser SKU (Stock Keeping Unit), especially for printers and computer peripherals which were once our core products. Online sales continue to be strong as we added more non IT products such as lifestyle and gaming products. However, margins remain low due to strong competition in this marketplace.

The Food and Beverage division is seeing a slowdown after the CNY (Chinese New Year) holidays which was due to the overall uncertainties faced in the current economic situation. Currently, we are sourcing for suitable locations for outlets

The board of directors are optimistic of showing a better set of results for the year 2019.
