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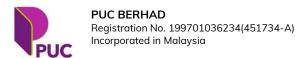

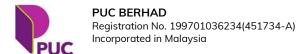

- (a) On 21 September 2023, Pictureworks Holdings Sdn Bhd ("PWHSB"), an associate of PUC, underwent an internal restructuring. This involved all shareholders of PWHSB exchanging their shares in PWHSB for new shares in Pictureworks International Holding Limited ("PWIH") ("Share Swap"). Following the Share Swap, PWHSB became an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of PWIH, and PWIH became an associate of PUC with a 27.53% equity stake.
- (b) PUC Berhad changed its financial year end ("FYE") from 31 December 2023 to 30 June 2024. The financial period is from 1 January 2023 to 30 June 2024, covering a period of 18 months. The change in FYE was to provide adequate time for the management team to implement an internal restructuring of the Group, to enhance the efficiency and coherence of the Group's diverse businesses, group structure and financial reporting.
- (c) On 5 February 2024, Presto Universe Sdn Bhd ("PRUMY") disposed its 100% shareholding of Presto Capital Sdn Bhd with consideration of RM1.
- (d) On 9 February 2024, PRUMY acquired a total of 60% shareholding from joint venture partners of Presto Power Sdn Bhd ("PPWMY") with total consideration of RM60. PPWMY then become a wholly owned subsidiary of PRUMY.
- (e) On 9 February 2024, PRUMY acquired a total of 30% shareholding from joint venture partners of Presto Assure Sdn Bhd ("PRAMY") with total consideration of RM1. After this acquisition, PRUMY held a total of 70% of shareholdings of PRAMY.
- (f) On 23 February 2024, a 100% shareholding of Presto Technology Sdn Bhd was transferred from PUC Berhad to PRUMY for a consideration of RM1.
- (g) On 3 April 2024, PRUMY disposed its 10% shareholding of Presto e-office Sdn Bhd with consideration of RM100.
- (h) On 30 May 2024, Presto Q-Commerce disposed its 30% shareholding of Leef Trading Sdn Bhd with consideration of RM600.
- (i) On 14 June 2024, Presto Mall Sdn Bhd, an associate of PUC, disposed its 20% shareholding of Presto Retail Sdn Bhd with consideration of RM20.

B1 Review of performance (Continued)

The financial year end has been changed from 31 December to 30 June. The reporting financial period will be for a period of 18 months, made up from 1 January 2023 to 30 June 2024. As such, there are no comparative figures for the current quarter for the 3 months ended 30 June 2024 and the period to date for the 18 months ended 30 June 2024. However, for the purposes of reference, the Company provides hereunder the comparative for the period 1 April 2024 to 30 June 2024 against 1 April 2023 to 30 June 2023.

The Group recorded higher revenue of RM1.82 million for the current quarter, as compared to the corresponding quarter of the preceding year's revenue of RM1.64 million. The segmental comparisons are as follows:

- (i) the OmniChannel segment recorded lower revenue in the current quarter, decreasing by 17.5% to RM1.21 million from RM1.47 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter. The shortfall was primarily attributable to a delay in the execution of media campaigns, originally scheduled for earlier implementation; and
- (ii) the Presto segment recorded higher revenue in the current quarter, increasing by 253.4% to RM0.61 million from RM0.17 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter. This was mainly attributable to higher project revenue related white labelled loyalty management system during the current quarter when compared with the corresponding quarter of the preceding year.

The Group recorded a loss after tax of RM40.37 million in the current quarter compared to a loss after tax of RM1.19 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter. The higher loss during the current quarter in comparison to the corresponding quarter of the preceding year was mainly due to below:

- a) Impairment loss of RM30.62 million on the investment in Presto Mall Sdn Bhd, an associate of PUC. This resulted from the shift of Presto business operations in the coming periods to be centralised under Presto Technology Sdn Bhd instead of Presto Mall Sdn Bhd;
- b) Additional provision of doubtful debt of RM2.17 million on receivables mainly related to debtors under Presto segment; and
- c) Impairment on goodwill of attributable to Presto Power Sdn Bhd of RM1.40 million, where its business is no longer able to earn sustainable future cash flows.

The share of losses of an associate company, PWIH under the OmniChannel segment, contributed a loss of RM0.46 million in the current quarter compared to a gain of RM0.58 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter. The loss in the current quarter was driven by higher operating costs mainly from both business regional expansion, such as setting up a new business entity and projects in Macau as well as ongoing corporate exercises. Under the Presto segment, the current quarter's loss of RM0.36 million when compared with RM0.25 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter was mainly due to higher marketing expenses incurred by Presto Mall Sdn Bhd to generate higher revenue under loyalty-to-redemption business in the current quarter.

The Group recorded higher revenue in the current quarter when compared with the immediate preceding quarter. This was mainly due to higher project revenue related white labelled loyalty management system under the Presto segment in the current quarter.

The loss in the current quarter when compared with the loss in the immediate preceding quarter was primarily due to expenses as listed in Note B1 above.

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B3 Prospects

After enduring several challenging years marked by low revenue activities, PUC's Presto segment is now on a promising path to growth. Recent increases in revenue activities under Presto Mall Sdn Bhd signify a pivotal turning point, underpinned by strategic adjustments, innovative product offerings, and an expanded market reach. These improvements are not only a testament to the resilience and adaptability of PUC but also reflect the growing confidence of our customers and stakeholders in our business model.

A key driver of this transformation has been the adoption of a new business model centred around loyalty-toredemption. This strategic shift is expected to yield significant improvements across multiple dimensions, including higher customer retention, increased customer lifetime value, enhanced brand loyalty, better operational efficiency and focused data-driven insights.

In the fiercely competitive media and advertising industry, PUC's OmniChannel segment has remained steadfast in its commitment to delivering value to the clients and stakeholders. PUC is determined to not only stay ahead of the competition but also to recapture the market share that has been lost. Among the key initiatives would include delivering innovative service offerings, providing client-centric solutions and forming strategic partnerships where such opportunities arise.

Looking ahead, PUC is committed to sustaining this positive momentum, and plans to capitalise the recent revenue gains by exploring new markets, diversifying product portfolios, and investing in advanced technologies that drive operational efficiency. PUC's focus will be on maintaining stringent cost controls while simultaneously pursuing high-margin opportunities to solidify its position in the industry.

Furthermore, PUC will seek strategic partnerships and alliances to enhance its competitive edge and expand its market presence. With a robust pipeline of initiatives aimed at further improving profitability, PUC will strive to transition from loss to sustained profit in the coming quarters.

We remain conservatively optimistic about the outlook for the Group's performance. The Group continues to tap into opportunities during the financial period ending 30 June 2024 and to support its ongoing expansion plans through internally generated financial resources and/or equity fundraising exercises.
