Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to MFRS 134

1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRSs") 134, *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These condensed consolidated interim financial statements also comply with International Accounting Standards ("IAS") 34, *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 30 June 2014. The explanatory notes attached to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 30 June 2014.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

Q1-2015 vs Q1-2014

The Group generated revenue of RM6.64 million for this quarter ended 30 September 2014 ("Q1-2015"), representing a decrease of RM4.34 million as compared to RM10.98 million generated in the previous year corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2013 ("Q1-2014").

The drop in revenue is a result of the downsizing effect of our businesses in Singapore, Indonesia and Thailand plus the saturation of market demand for existing products through our distribution business locally. The clearance of stock at a significantly reduced margin also contributed to the increased losses experienced.

The increase in loss before tax of RM0.69 million (from RM1.38 million in Q1-2014 to loss before tax of RM2.07 million in Q1-2015) is due to the lower revenue.

Q1-2015 vs Q4-2014

When compared to the previous quarter ended 30 June 2014 ("Q4-2014"), revenue of The Group decreased by RM1.64 million from RM8.28 million to RM6.64 million in Q1-2015.

The loss before tax for Q1-2015 was significantly lower as compared to the RM17.14 million incurred in Q4-2014 is due to the significant impairment of loss on goodwill, inventory written off, impairment loss on interest in a joint venture, allowances for impairment losses on receivables and product development expenditure written off, in the preceding quarter.

16. Commentary on Prospects

The Group's current focus is to continue to reduce expenses and to consolidate manpower and focus on the sales channels which have strong potential.

The introduction of new products under our distribution business, namely our WayLED (LED Sensor Lighting) and WayHome (Smart Home Solutions) products are geared to help boost returns from related subsidiaries and to hopefully counter the drop in our conventional sales from GPS and Driving Video Recorders. The i3D Interactive Digital Terminals have also seen positive responses in recent months, as is expected to improve in the next few quarters, with new and existing clients increasing their demand for such terminals.

This difficult and challenging period continues, and our priority lies in consolidating our efforts - to regroup and restructure our operations and strategies for each business unit to prevent further losses and to achieve a break even scenario by the end of FY2015, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
