A. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD 134

1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and Chapter 9, Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") for the MESDAQ Market.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2007. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended December 31, 2007.

Save for the changes in accounting policies as set out in Note A2, the accounting policies and presentation adopted for the interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted for the audited financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2007.

B. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 9, APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD FOR THE MESDAQ MARKET

1. Performance Review

The Group's revenue for the current financial period ended June 30, 2008 of RM16.716 million is higher than the revenue in the prior corresponding financial period ended June 30, 2007 of RM13.866 million. The profit before tax for the period ended June 30, 2008 amounted to RM3.366 million, which is approximate the profit before tax of RM3.362 million for the previous year's corresponding financial period.

The Group's revenue for the current quarter ended June 30, 2008 increased to RM8.272 million from RM6.964 million in the quarter ended June 30, 2007 while the profit before tax increased to RM1.527 million from RM1.413 million for the respective periods.

Though the Group's revenue improved compared to the previous year's corresponding period, the growth in revenue is mainly from precision plastic injection moulding division. As this division generates a lower profit margin, the Group's profit before tax for the six-month period ended June 30, 2008 was similar to the previous year's corresponding period notwithstanding the Group's improvement in revenue. The net profit of the Group is lower than the previous year's corresponding quarter/period due to higher tax provision.

There are no other material factors which have affected the revenue and profit before tax of the Group for the current quarter/financial period-to-date.

2. Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Tax

The pre-tax profit of RM1.527 million for the current quarter was lower than the pre-tax profit of RM1.839 million in the preceding quarter due to lower revenue generated in the current quarter.

3. Current Year Prospects

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Directors are of the opinion that the performance of the Group will be maintained in year 2008.
