# A. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD 134 – INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

#### A1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and Chapter 9, Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") for the ACE Market.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2009. These explanatory notes attached to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2009.

#### A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The adoption of these standards, amendments and interpretations has no effect on the interim financial statements of the Group except for the following:

### (i) FRS 101 (revised): Presentation of Financial Statements

With the adoption of the revised FRS 101, all non-owner changes in equity are presented in the consolidated statement of comprehensive income. The consolidated statement of changes in equity only includes details of transactions with owners. The adoption of this standard does not have any impact on the financial position and results of the Group.

#### (ii) FRS 139: Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement

Prior to the adoption of FRS 139, derivative contracts were recognised in the financial statements on settlement dates. With the adoption of FRS 139, derivative contracts are now categorised as fair value through profit or loss and measured at their fair values with the gain or loss recognised in the profit or loss.

In accordance with the transitional provisions of FRS 139, the above changes are applied prospectively and the comparatives as at 31 December 2009 are not restated. The adoption of FRS 139 does not have any significant impact on the results of the Group.

### A3. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2009 were not subject to any qualification.

### A4. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

# B. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 9, APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD FOR THE ACE MARKET

#### **B1.** Performance Review

The Group's revenue for the current financial year ended 31 December 2010 of RM36.647 million is higher than the revenue in the prior corresponding financial year ended 31 December 2009 of RM29.264 million. The profit before tax for the year ended 31 December 2010 amounted to RM5.919 million, which is also higher than the profit before tax of RM2.453 million for the previous year's corresponding financial year. The increase in revenue and profit before tax of 25.2% and 141.3% respectively was mainly due to the recovery in the connectors, semiconductor and the electrical and electronics industries this year. The Group experienced improved revenue in both the precision engineering and precision plastic injection moulding divisions.

The Group achieved a revenue of RM9.788 million for the current quarter ended 31 December 2010, which is lower than the revenue for the quarter ended 31 December 2009 of RM10.132 million whilst profit before tax for the current quarter ended 31 December 2010 increased to RM2.230 million from RM1.315 million in the quarter ended 31 December 2009. Revenue decreased mainly due to the precision plastic injection moulding division receiving components on consignment basis from its customer and charging for its value-added services only. However, profit before tax for both the precision engineering and precision plastic injection moulding divisions have increased compared to the previous year corresponding quarter due to improve volume of business.

Net cash from operating activities increased from RM5.594 million to RM8.284 million in the current financial year. Cash flows used in investing activities increased to RM4.345 million due to higher capital expenditure to improve the Group's production capacity and efficiency. Cash flows used in financing activities was RM4.066 million mainly due to dividends paid to shareholders amounting to RM3.747 million. Cash and cash equivalents at end of year remained at RM10.818 million.

There are no other material factors which have affected the revenue and profit before tax of the Group for the current year/quarter.

#### B2. Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Tax

The pre-tax profit increased to RM2.230 million as compared to RM0.932 million in the preceding quarter mainly due to higher revenue in the current quarter.



#### **B3.** Current Year Prospects

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Directors are of the opinion that the performance of the Group for the financial year ending 31 December 2011 will be maintained as per year 2010.

#### **B12.** Material Litigations

#### B13. Dividends

On 24 February 2011, the Company declared a special tax-exempt dividend of 10% equivalent to 1.0 sen per share in respect of financial year ended 31 December 2010, to be paid on 23 March 2011 to all holders of ordinary shares whose names appeared in the Record of Depositors at the close of business on 14 March 2011.

With the special tax-exempt dividend of 10% equivalent to 1.0 sen per share, the dividend payout ratio for the financial year ended 31 December 2010 will be 106% of the Group's profit for the year.

Total dividends declared for the financial year ended 31 December 2010 include the following:

- i. A first interim dividend of 10%, tax-exempt, equivalent to 1.0 sen per share, amounting to RM1,873,718 in respect of financial year ending 31 December 2010 was paid by the Company on 21 September 2010 to all holders of ordinary shares whose names appeared in the Record of Depositors at the close of business on 7 September 2010.
- ii. A second interim tax-exempt dividend of 10% equivalent to 1.0 sen per share, amounting to RM1,873,718 in respect of financial year ending 31 December 2010 was paid by the Company on 13 December 2010 to all holders of ordinary shares whose names appeared in the Record of Depositors at the close of business on 30 November 2010.
- iii. A special tax-exempt dividend of 10% equivalent to 1.0 sen per share, amounting to RM1,873,718 in respect of financial year ended 31 December 2010, to be paid on 23 March 2011 to all holders of ordinary shares whose names appeared in the Record of Depositors at the close of business on 14 March 2011.
