#### **B1.** Performance Review

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of approximately RM5.5 million, which is approximately 4% higher than the revenue of RM5.3 million for the preceding year's corresponding quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2009.

In line with the increase in revenue and contribution from the share of associated company's profit, the Group recorded a higher profit before taxation of approximately RM0.7 million as compared to the profit before taxation of approximately RM0.3 million for the preceding year's corresponding quarter.

#### **B2.** Variation of Results against the Preceding Quarter

The Group recorded higher revenue of approximately RM5.5 million in the current quarter under review as compared to RM5.1 million in the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2009 as a result of higher completion of projects from its existing order book. The Group recorded a higher profit before taxation in the current quarter as compared to preceding quarter due mainly to higher revenue recorded and contribution from share of associated company's profit in the current quarter.

The Group ended the current quarter with a secured order book of RM27.1 million as compared to RM19.6 million as at the end of immediate preceding quarter.

#### **B3.** Prospect

With the economic recovery in the ASEAN region, the Group expects a gradual increase in demand for healthcare and e-government solutions. Hence, we are cautiously optimistic that the Group's results will be satisfactory for the current financial year.

#### **B4.** Profit Forecast and Profit Guarantee

The Group has not issued any profit forecast or profit guarantee.
