ADSB is a private limited company incorporated in Malaysia on 2 March 2011. The authorised share capital of ADSB is RM100,000 comprising 100,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each and the total issued and paid up share capital of RM2.00 comprising 2 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each. Presently, ADSB is dormant and would be carrying out Local and Overseas Joint Ventures in IT related business and products.

Following the Acquisition, ADSB becomes a wholly owned sub-subsidiary of ISB.

(b) On 8 April 2011, Ingenuity Solutions Bhd ("ISB") acquired the entire two (2) ordinary shares of RM1.00 each representing 100% equity interest in Hallmark Avenue Sdn Bhd ("HASB") for a total consideration of RM 2.00.

HASB is a private limited company incorporated in Malaysia on 18 March 2011. The authorised share capital of HASB is RM100,000 comprising 100,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each and the total issued and paid up capital is RM2.00 comprising 2 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each. HASB would be carrying out Supply and Distribution of IT Hardware and Software and other IT related business and products.

Following the acquisition, HASB becomes a wholly owned subsidiary of ISB.

(c) On 6 May 2011, Ingenuity Solutions Bhd ("ISB") incorporated a wholly owned subsidiary, Ingenuity Care Sdn. Bhd. ("ICSB") under the Companies Act,1965. The authorised share capital of ICSB is RM100,000.00 comprising 100,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each and total issued and paid up capital is RM10.00 comprising 10 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each.

ICSB will provide extended warranty services to retail based users as well as small businesses. The extended warranty will cover mainly three categories of products, namely desktop PC, notebook and mobile phone. ICSB will focus on development of the services product, marketing and provision of high level responsiveness and quality support services. ICSB plans to market and distribute the extended warranty services as an optional to value added to end users.

(d) On 21 February 2012, ISB has completed the acquisition of 100 fully paid ordinary shares of VistaVision Resources Sdn.Bhd. ("VVR") for a purchase consideration of RM15,452,000.00, which will be fully satisfied by the issuance of 154,520,000 new ordinary shares of the Company at issue price of RM0.10.

VVR was incorporated in Malaysia as a private limited company under the Act under its present name on 31 March 2011. VVR is principally an investment holding company and has 3 wholly-owned subsidiaries, direct and indirect, namely Ingens Sdn. Bhd. ("Ingens"), Inconnecxion Communication Sdn. Bhd.and DSS Distribution Sdn. Bhd., which is wholly owned by Ingens. VVR's subsidiary companies are principally involved in the distribution of IT and telecommunication products and accessories. Its target markets are IT resellers throughout Malaysia.

The authorised share capital of VVR is RM100,00 comprising 100,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each and issued and paid-up capital of RM100 comprising 100 ordinary shares RM1.00 each.

Upon completion of the above acquisition, VVR became wholly owned subsidiary company of ISB.

B EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD ("BURSA SECURITIES") FOR THE ACE MARKET

B1 Review of performance of the Company and its principal subsidiaries

The Group revenue for the 4th quarter ended 31 March 2012 (Q4-2011/12) of RM63.93 million represents an improvement of RM 57.7 million or an increase of 926.2% as compared to RM6.23 million in preceding year's corresponding quarter (Q4-2010/11). The increase in revenue mainly due to the ICT distribution business which contributed RM55.16 million or 86.3% of the total revenue.

The Group registered a pre-tax loss of RM 3.13 million in Q4-2011/12 as compared to RM 1.41 million in Q4-2010/11. Current year pre-tax loss was mainly due to low profit margin charged from IT hardware distribution business and gradual increase in manpower costs, administrative expenses, amortisation charges and additional corporate exercise expenses incurred associated with the acquisition of Vistavision Resources ("VVR") group of companies as compared to previous corresponding year.

(i) ICT Distribution

Revenue derived from ICT Distribution for the fourth quarter and financial year ended 31 March 2012 were RM 33.96 million and RM 55.16 million respectively. The increase in revenue partially attributable to the VVR which was consolidated as part of the Group's result with effect from March 2012 which contributed RM 32.25 million or 50.4% for the group's revenue.

(ii) Enterprise Systems

Revenue derived from Enterprise Systems for the fourth quarter and financial year ended 31 March 2012 were RM3.52 million and RM8.77 million respectively. This segment registered higher loss for the financial year was mainly attributable to the increase in headcounts and depreciation & amortisation costs as compared to previous financial year.

B2 Material change in the quarterly results compared to the results of the immediate preceding quarter

The current quarter (Q4-2011/12) revenue of RM 37.48 million represents an increase of RM 24.51 million or 189.0% over the preceding quarter (Q3-2011/12) revenue of RM 12.97 million. The higher pre-tax loss of RM 1.22 million as compared to pre-tax loss of RM0.55 million for the immediate preceding quarter was mainly due to lower margin from IT distribution business and gradually increase of operating expenses.

B3 Current year prospects

(Commentary on next year)

Moving forward, the management's priority is to continue to penetrate into existing markets and to explore opportunities through development of new products and services. With the completed acquisition of VVR in fourth quarter of 2011/2012 and recent successfully secured the sole distributorship right from Packet One Networks (M) Sdn Bhd to supply P1 WIMAX brand throughout Malaysia may contribute positively to the group revenue and profitability. Furthermore, the Group has also taken steps to implement control measures in order to achieve greater operational efficiency and effectiveness. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, with all these strategies planned out and government's ICT friendly policies, the Board expects the Group to perform reasonably well in 2012/2013.

B4 Profit Forecast/Profit Guarantee
