Notes to the Interim Financial Report

For the second quarter ended 30 June 2015

A. EXPLANATORY NOTES

A1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the Malaysia Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRSs") 134 – *Interim Financial Reporting* and Rule 9.22 of the ACE Marketing Listing Requirements ("AMLR") of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2014.

The significant accounting policies adopted by the Group are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2014.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements are the Group's first MFRS condensed consolidated interim financial statements and MFRS 1 – First-time Adoption of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards has been applied. The transition of MFRS framework does not have any material financial impact to the financial statements of the Group.

A2. Auditors' Report

The auditors' report for the Group's annual financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2014 was not subject to any qualification.

A3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The Group does not experience any significant seasonal or cyclical sales cycle. However, there may be fluctuations between the quarters due to the nature of the Group's integration businesses which are secured on a project by project basis.

A4. Unusual Items

During the financial quarter under review, there were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows of the Group.

A5. Material Changes in Estimates

There were no changes in the estimate of amounts reported in the prior quarter or financial year which have material effect on the current quarter results.



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A6. Changes in Debts and Equity Securities

On 29 June 2015, the Proposed Par Value Reduction involves a cancellation of RM0.05 of the existing par value of every ordinary shares of RM0.10 each to RM0.05 each in the Company pursuant to the Section 64(1) of the Companies Act, 1965 took effect with the lodgment of the Court Order with the Companies Commission of Malaysia. Pursuant to the Par Value Reduction, the par value of each existing ordinary share in KAG has been reduced from RM0.10 to RM0.05 each.

There were no other issuance and repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellation, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares during the current quarter under review.

A7. Dividend

No dividend has been declared or paid during the current financial year-to-date under review.

A8. Segmental Reporting

The Group's reportable segments were identified as follows:

- Information Communication Technology ("ICT") Services Provision of comprehensive range of ICT and other information technology related services including trading of hardware and software and related services
- Kitchen Appliances Services Provision of distributing and reselling of kitchen appliances and related services

Other non-reportable comprise operations related to investment holding and 3D interior design and image consultants' services.

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B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD'S LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1. Review of Performance

The Group recorded revenue of RM9.38 million, 19.04% or RM1.5 million higher than RM7.88 million recorded in the corresponding quarter last year.

The Group recorded a net loss after taxation of RM1.24 million as compared to the last year corresponding quarter's loss after taxation of RM110,000. This performance is as a result of increase of project cost due to competitive market for the quarter under review and the impairment loss on amount owing by the disposed subsidiary. The Group has been actively pursuing for new businesses with positive feedbacks for the coming future.

The performance of the respective business segments for the quarter ended 30 June 2015 as compared to the last year corresponding quarter is analysed as follows:-

1) ICT Services

The ICT services segment recorded revenue of RM8.03 million in the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2015 from RM7.88 million in the last year corresponding quarter, representing increase of 1.9%. Digital Paper Solutions Sdn Bhd has recorded revenue of RM5.55 million for the quarter under review.

2) Kitchen Appliances Services

No segment review done for this quarter as this is the new business venture with new income stream brought to the group whereby no comparative figures are available.

B2. Future Prospect

The Board is of the view that the Group's prospect will remain challenging in near future.

B3. Changes in Profit/Loss before Taxation against Immediate Preceding Quarter

For the current quarter under review, the Group's revenue was RM9.38 million represents a decrease of RM2.2 million as compared to immediate preceding corresponding quarter revenue of RM11.58 million. This was attributed to the decrease of billing in projects after completion in the quarter under review.

Current quarter recorded a loss after tax of RM1.24 million as compared to a loss after tax of RM0.80 million for the immediate preceding corresponding quarter.



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B3. Changes in Profit/Loss before Taxation against Immediate Preceding Quarter

The performance of the respective business segments for the quarter ended 30 June 2015 as compared to the immediate preceding corresponding quarter is analysed as follows:-

1) ICT Services

The ICT services segment recorded revenue of RM8.03 million in the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2015 from RM6.05 million in the last year corresponding quarter, representing an increase of 32.73%. The increase in revenue was due to the effort in management seeking for opportunities.

2) Kitchen Appliances Services

The kitchen appliances services segment recorded revenue of RM1.25 million in the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2015 as compared to immediate preceding corresponding quarter revenue of RM5.18 million. This segment recorded a loss after taxation of RM0.8 million in the current quarter under review as compared to immediate preceding corresponding quarter profit after taxation of RM45,000. This is due to the significant depreciation of ringgit and the implementation of Goods and Service Tax ("GST) which affects consumer sentiments and spending.

Private Placement

On 25 February 2014, the Company ("Company" or "KGROUP") announced proposed private placement of up to ten percent (10%) of the issued and paid-up share capital of KGROUP ("Proposed Private Placement").

Bursa Securities Berhad had, vide its letter dated 20 March 2014, approved the listing of and quotation for up to 87,120,000 Placement Shares, representing up to ten percent (10%) of the enlarged issued and paid-up share capital of KGROUP.

Bursa Securities Berhad had, vide its letter dated 22 September 2014, approved the extension of time of 6 months from 20 September 2014 until 19 March 2015 to complete the implementation of the Proposed Private Placement. Bursa Securities Berhad, vide its letter dated 16 March 2015 granted the Company an extension of time until 19 September 2015 to complete the Proposed Private Placement.

The Company is in the midst of identifying suitable placee.

Multiple Proposals

On 11 February 2015, the Company ("Company" or "KGROUP") announced the following proposals:

(i) Proposed Par Value Reduction

Proposed reduction of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company pursuant to Section 64(1) of the Companies Act, 1965 involving the cancellation of RM0.05 of the par value of the ordinary share of RM0.10 each in KAG to RM0.05 each in KAG.

(ii) Proposed Share Issuance Scheme ("SIS")

Proposed establishment and implementation of a share issuance scheme of up to thirty percent (30%) of the Company's issued and paid-up share capital (excluding treasury shares, if any) at any one time during the duration of the scheme, for the Directors and employees of KAG and its subsidiaries.

(iii) Proposed Amendment to the Memorandum of Association of the Company

Proposed amendment to the Memorandum of Association of the Company to facilitate the Proposed Par Value Reduction.

On 10 April 2015, the Company had obtained shareholders' approval for the multiple proposals.

The Company announced that the effective date for the implementation of the SIS is 7 May 2015, which is the date of full compliance of the SIS in accordance with Rule 6.44(1) of the Listing Requirements.
