#### 1. Review of the performance of the Company and its subsidiaries

The Group registered a profit after tax of RM29.23 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2017, an increase of RM26.17 million compared to a profit after tax of RM3.06 million for the preceding nine months ended 30 September 2016. This was mainly due to the net fair value gain on financial instruments of RM30.06 million and RM0.23 million respectively.

For the current quarter under review, the Group posted a loss after tax of RM15.06 million as compared to a profit after tax of RM5.52 million of the corresponding quarter in 2016. The loss after tax was due to decrease in income earned in the current quarter and net fair value loss on financial instruments of RM15.26 million as compared to net fair value gain on financial instruments of RM4.18 million in the corresponding quarter in 2016.

# 2. Material change in quarterly results before taxation for the current quarter compared with the immediate preceding quarter

The Group recorded a loss before tax of RM15.85 million in the third quarter of 2017 as compared to a profit before tax of RM31.29 million in the immediate preceding quarter. This was mainly due to decrease in market value in quoted investments held by the Group for the current quarter under review.

### 3. Current prospects and progress on previously announced financial estimate

#### (a) Current prospects

For the coming financial year, we will be maintaining our focus on companies with strong growth prospects and good product offering for our private investment portfolio. We have a strong pipeline of deals in various stages and we intend to close a number of these investments within the next twelve months. Meanwhile, our public investment portfolio has been seeing a healthy growth in volume and geographical diversity since the beginning of this year which we expect to continue in this current quarter. Nevertheless, we will continue to be mindful of the increasing volatility in the market and strive to optimise our performance to ensure long-term sustainability and profitability through continuous effort to seek new opportunities for both our portfolios.
