The Fire Incident had affected small area of the HLSB Factory, caused some damages to the raw materials and finished products and disruption to two (2) PVC production lines.

As at to-date, HLSB had received a total of RM1 million interim compensation sum from the insurance company and the financial impact to KIB and its subsidiaries in relation to the Fire Incident has yet to be finalised.

Further developments of the above matter will be announced to Bursa Securities in due course.

6. Material Changes in Estimates

There were no material changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years that have material effect on the current financial period-to-date.
