A. EXPLANATORY NOTES AS PER FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD ("FRS") NO. 134

A1. Basic of Preparation

The interim financial report has been prepared in compliance with FRS No. 134, Interim Financial Reporting and Rule 9.22 of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the annual audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2008.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group for this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2008.

The Group has not adopted FRS No. 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement and the consequential amendments resulting from FRS No. 139 of which are effective for annual reporting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2010.

A2. Audit Report

The audit report on the Group's preceding annual financial statements was not subject to any audit qualification.

A3. Seasonality or Cyclicality of Interim Operations

There were no seasonal or cyclical factors affecting the results of the Group for the current financial quarter under review.

A4. Unusual Items Affecting Assets, Liabilities, Equity, Net Income or Cash Flows

During the current financial quarter under review, there were no items or events that arose, which affected assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows, that are unusual by reason of their nature, size or incidence.

A5. Changes in Estimates

There was no material changes in estimates of amounts reported in the prior financial year that has a material effect on the current financial quarter under review.

A6. Debt and Equity Securities

The issued and paid-up share capital of the Company was increased from RM12.11 million to RM12.57 million through the issuance of 4.61 million new ordinary shares of RM0.10 each for cash pursuant to the Company's Employees' Share Option Scheme (ESOS) at an exercise price of RM0.29 and RM0.23 per ordinary share.

Save for the above, there were no issuance and repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellation, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares for the current financial quarter under review.

A7. Dividend Paid

No dividend was declared or paid during the current financial quarter under review.

There was no material event subsequent to the current financial quarter ended 31 December 2009 up to the date of the announcement of this report which is likely to substantially affect the results of the operations of the Group for the quarter under review.

A11. Changes in the Composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the current financial quarter under review.

A12. Changes in Contingent Liabilities or Contingent Assets

There were no material contingent liabilities or contingent assets for the current financial quarter under review.

A13. Recurrent Related Party Transactions ("RRPT")

There were no RRPT in the Group during the current financial quarter under review.

B. EXPLANATORY NOTES AS PER ACE MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENT (APPENDIX 9B)

B1. Review of Performance for the Current Financial Quarter

For the current financial quarter ended 31 December 2009, the Group achieved revenue of RM3.32 million (31.12.08: RM2.17 million) and profit before taxation ("PBT") of RM1.95 million (31.12.08: RM0.62 million). The current financial quarter under review recorded an increase of 53% and 214% in revenue and PBT respectively as compared to the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This is mainly due to higher sales generated from AS and higher trading volume in the ASP business segments. AS's sales was mainly driven by contribution from overseas sales in Vietnam and Indonesia.

The higher trading volume of ASP business segment for current financial quarter compared with the same period last year was due to improved confidence and growth prospects in the global economic outlook. Generally, global activities in equity trading improved from the low in March of 2009. Bursa Malaysia's trading volume and confidence also improved in tandem.

For the twelve (12) months financial period ended 31 December 2009, the Group achieved a total revenue of RM12.12 million (31.12.08: RM11.49 million) and PBT of RM6.19 million (31.12.08: RM5.45 million).

The cumulative financial quarter ended 31 December 2009 showed a 5.5% and 13.6% increase in revenue and PBT respectively as compared to the corresponding cumulative quarter in the preceding year. ASP segment contributed approximately 68.9% of total revenue and this segment grew by 20.6% (RM1.4m) if compared to previous year. PBT also improved significantly compare to previous year as a result of recovery of doubtful debts, lower project cost, marketing expenses and operational expenses.

B2. Comparison with Previous Financial Quarter's PBT

PBT of RM1.95 million for the current financial quarter under review was higher than the PBT of RM1.53 million recorded in the previous quarter. This was due mainly to increase in revenue by 11.94% during the quarter under review. In addition, other income increased by 3.95% and expenses decreased by 4.31% which improved the PBT of current financial quarter.

B3. Prospects for 2010

The Board takes cognisance of the current challenging market environment. Notwithstanding, the Board is of the view that barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group is optimistic of achieving better performance for the coming year.

B4. Variance of Profit Forecast and Shortfall in Profit Guarantee

The Group has not issued any profit forecast nor profit guarantee for the current financial quarter under review and the financial period to-date.

B5. Taxation

The Group has been granted Pioneer Tax Status under the Promotion of Investments (Amendment) Act, 1997. Therefore, the Group is exempted from tax on business income. The reported tax expense is attributed to interest income on term deposits and withholding tax arising from foreign sales proceeds.

B6. Sale of Unquoted Investments and/or Properties

There were no disposal of unquoted investments and/or properties by the Group during the current financial quarter and the cumulative financial quarter under review.

B7. Ouoted and Marketable Securities

There was no purchase or disposal of quoted and marketable securities during the current financial quarter under review.

B8. Status of Corporate Proposals

There were no corporate proposals announced but not completed as at the date of this report.

B9. Borrowings and Debt Securities

The Company does not have any borrowings and debt securities as at 31 December 2009. However, on 8 January 2007, the Company acquired four (4) units of new office block located at Jaya 1, Section 13, Petaling Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan ("Properties") for a total purchase consideration of RM2.150 million ("Acquisition"). The Acquisition is financed by secured bank borrowings (approximately 80%) and internally generated funds (approximately 20%). This term loan is for a period of ten (10) years and it has a feature of Savelink Term Loan where interest shall only be calculated at the prescribed rate on the daily outstanding amount.



B10. Off Balance Sheet Financial Instruments

The Company does not have any off balance sheet financial instruments as at the date of this report.

B11. Material Litigation

Save as disclosed below, the Group is not engaged in any material litigation either as plaintiff or defendant and the Board do not have any knowledge of any proceedings pending or threatened against the Group as at the date of this report.

Kuala Lumpur High Court Originating Summons No. D7-24-118-2007 Automatic Identification Technology Sdn Bhd v Excel Force MSC Bhd

Excel Force MSC Bhd ("EFMB") served a Statutory Notice pursuant to Section 218 of the Companies Act 1965 against Automatic Identification Technology Sdn Bhd ("AIT") on 30 March 2007 for non-payment of a sum of RM150,000, being the cost of application, software installation and system configuration at the business premises owned by the end client. For this reason, AIT filed an application vide Originating Summons No. D7-24-118-2007, which inter alia prayed for an injunction restraining EFMB to proceed further for winding-up petition against AIT.

The case was called for hearing and the High Court had on 29 February 2008 dismissed AIT's application and Originating Summons. Thereafter, AIT filed an appeal against the High Court decision and the case is pending appeal at the Court of Appeal.

No dividend was declared or paid during the current financial quarter under review.
