B. EXPLANATORY NOTES AS PER MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS (APPENDIX 9B)

B1. Review of Group's Performance

Current Year- to date vs. Previous Year-to date

For the financial half year ending 30 June 2013, the Group registered a turnover of RM10.352 million, 5% (or RM450K) higher than the same period last year. The increase in the revenue was mainly due to growth contribution from Maintenance and Application Service Provider (ASP) segment, which achieved 347% and 31% growth respectively.

The Gross Profit (GP) for the 6 months period ending 30 June 2013 has increase by RM1.290 million, represent 21% compared to previous year corresponding period. This is due to lower purchases and lower direct technical staff cost. The GP margin has also increase from 62% to 72%.

The PBT for the 6 months ending 30 June 2013 has improve from RM4.081 million to RM5.163 million, a growth of RM1.082 million compared to previous year same period. However, the PAT for the same corresponding period has dropped from RM4.047 million to RM3.880 million. This is due to extra tax payable after the expiry of pioneer status on 15 May 2012.

The Group's revenue for current quarter had decreased by RM1.554 million represent 26% lower compared to the immediate preceding quarter. This was mainly due to lower sales generated from Application Solution (AS) and maintenance segment.

PBT in current quarter stood at RM1.617 million, a decrease of 54% or RM1.93 million compared to immediate preceding quarter mainly due to lower revenue, higher purchases and lower interest income.

Similarly, PAT had also reduced to RM1.218 million compared to RM2.662 million recorded in preceding quarter.

B3. Prospects for 2013

Looking ahead, the Group will continue to focus on enhancement, development and implementation of its products. In spite of uncertainties in world economic climate, the Board remains optimistic of achieving a satisfactory performance for the financial year ending 31 December 2013.
