B1 Review of performance

For the quarter under review, Group 's revenue at RM 1.98 million showed decrease of RM 4.98 million (or 72%) from RM 6.96 million of the preceding year corresponding quarter.

The Group recorded loss before tax of RM0.61 million for the quarter under review as compared to loss before tax of RM0.79 million in the preceeding year corresponding quarter (Q3-2018). The decrease in loss before tax of approximately RM0.18 million as compared to the corresponding quarter in preceeding year was mainly due to proceed gain from disposal of Fixed Asset and sharp drop in finance cost.

B2 Variation of results against immediate preceding quarter

During the quarter under review, sales decreased by RM 0.28 million (Revenue, Q3-2019: RM 1.98 million - Q2-2019: RM 2.26 million) compared to previous quarter. The decrease of sales was mainly due to low demand from automation.

The group has recorded a loss before tax of RM 0.61 million in the guarter under review, improvement of RM 1.61 million compared to a loss before tax of RM 2.22 million in the preceeding quarters (Q2-2019). Lower loss before tax as compared to the corresponding quarter in preceeding year was mainly due to significant reduction in finance cost (Reduce RM10k) and operating expenses (Reduce RM2.2 million) effect from adjustment of disposal MPTS.

B3 Prospects for the forthcoming financial year

Manufacturing business component

The outlook for Group's tooling and precision components business is expected to maintain the existing business level for the financial year 2019. There are various cost saving measures have been implaced to improve the Gross Profit margin and lower the operating expenditures.

Theme park

The theme park component of the Group has yet to be fully operational and is not expected to contribute significantly to the Group in Q2 2019.
