The Broadband Services business recorded lower 1Q13 revenue against 1Q12 mainly due to the decline in project based revenue arising from a more competitive market environment even with a stronger subscriber base of some 541,000 subscribers against 446,000 subscribers in 1Q12. The Communication Services business continues to demonstrate significant growth with the securing of new routes and new customer accounts.
