# B. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD FOR THE ACE MARKET

# **B1.** Review of performance

The Group's total revenue for the quarter under review was RM9.219 million as compared to RM19.254 million in the corresponding period of the preceding year.

The decrease in revenue for the current quarter was mainly due to lower revenue derived from both local and overseas market as compared to the corresponding period of the preceding year. Revenue from local sales decreased subsequent to the change of consumers spending pattern and the revenue for overseas market decreased mainly due to less sales orders for the current quarter as compared to the corresponding period of the preceding year.

The Group's loss before tax ("LBT") for the current quarter was RM1.260 million as compared to profit before tax of RM1.837 million in the corresponding period of the preceding year. This was mainly due to the significant drop in revenue as highlighted above as well as an increase in administrative expenses arising from staff costs subsequent to the increase in headcount. Selling and distribution expenses did not fall correspondingly with the drop in revenue as the Group continued to spend on the advertising and promotion of INS Wheatgrass Canned Drinks.

For the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2011, the Group recorded a total revenue and LBT of RM9.219 million and RM1.260 million respectively, as compared to a total revenue and LBT of RM11.381 million and RM22.207 million respectively as recorded in the preceding financial quarter ended 31 March 2011.

The decrease of approximately RM2.162 million in Group revenue for the current quarter was mainly due to the decrease in revenue from the overseas market. LBT for the current quarter of RM1.260 million as compared to LBT for the preceding quarter of RM22.207 million shows an improvement as there was no further occurrence of other operating expenses that was incurred in the preceding financial quarter ended 31 March 2011, such as allowance for slow moving inventories, plant and equipment written off, impairment loss on goodwill and allowance for impairment losses on receivables.

### **B3.** Prospects

In line with the Group's business development and expansion plans, the Group continues to focus on its plan to expand its franchise business in healthcare retailing by launching more franchise retail outlets throughout the country.

The Group will continue its effort of merchandising the Strategic Alliance Partner ("SAP") program. The SAP products' variety and merchantable quantity will be largely increased to cater for consumers needs and shall be widely sold via franchise retail outlets as well as through the e-commerce portal.

The Group had launched a programme namely "Sihat 1 Malaysia" ("S1M") in mid June 2011. It is a Personalised Health Management program which promotes the awareness that "prevention is better than cure" as well as the importance of personal health towards the family and community. The S1M provides the consumers and members with healthcare products, SAP products, health screening and a comprehensive personalised health management service. The Group expects positive growth in revenue from the said programme.

The Group will continue to distribute Easy Pha-max brand name products and INS Wheatgrass Canned Drinks locally and internationally. The INS Wheatgrass Canned Drinks has laid a good foundation in the overseas market, particularly in the People's Republic of China ("PRC"), Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Africa, Thailand and Philippines. The Group expects positive growth from its overseas market for the INS Wheatgrass Canned Drinks, especially through the distribution and marketing by its jointly controlled company, Guangzhou YiXi Drinks Co., Ltd ("YiXi"), a company incorporated in the PRC.

In line with supporting the Group's development plans, the Group will continue to launch new products in the forthcoming year, which is expected to further contribute to the Group's total revenue in year 2012. The prospects of the Group are also dependent on the progress of the market penetration of the Group's products.
