A. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD ("MFRS") 134 INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

A1. Basis of Preparation

The shares bought back are held as treasury shares in accordance with Section 67A Subsection 3(A)(b) of the Companies Act, 1965.

B. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENT OF BURSA SECURITIES FOR THE ACE MARKET

B1. Review of Performance

For the cumulative quarter ended 31 March 2013, the Group achieved Revenue of approximately RM9.2 million and Profit Before Taxation ("PBT") of RM0.8 million. Revenue from matured market remained consistent at RM8.1 million whereas revenue from emerging markets decreased from RM1.9 million to RM1.0 million as compared to the preceding corresponding quarter. The decrease in revenue from emerging markets was mainly due to lower third party partner traffic. The Gross Profit Margin decreased by 8% from 46% to 38% as compared to the preceding corresponding quarter due to changes of the business mix.

B2. Material Changes in Profit Before Taxation In Comparison to the Previous Quarter

The Group recorded an increase of 2% in Revenue which increased from RM9.0 million for the previous quarter to RM9.2 million for the current quarter. The Group's Gross Profit for the current quarter increased by 5.1% from RM3.3 million in the previous quarter to RM3.5 million in the current quarter. The Group's PBT decreased by 28% from RM1.1 million in the previous quarter to RM0.8 million in the current quarter. There were no material expenses incurred in the quarter under review.

B3. Future Prospect

The Group will continue to focus on its core mobile messaging services and drive the existing and new products across the six (6) main countries of operation ie Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Hong Kong, Indonesia and Vietnam.

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the Directors of MTB are optimistic of the prospects ahead.
