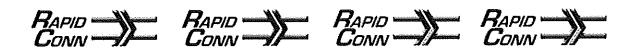

NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 30 JUNE 2013

A EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS ("FRS") 134 INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

A1 BASIS OF PREPARATION

The unaudited interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with MFRS134: Interim Financial Reporting Issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Rule 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") for the ACE Market.

The unaudited interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to the understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation applied in the unaudited interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted in the most recent annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012.

A2 AUDIT REPORT OF THE PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

There were no audit qualification on the financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 other than an audit emphasis of matter by the independent auditor as follows:

Rapid Conn Interconnect (M) Sdn. Bhd.'s auditor's report contain the audit emphasis of matter relating to the appropriateness of going concern basis of accounting is dependent on the success of the future operations and financial support from its holding Company and its fellow subsidiaries and/or its attaining sufficient cash inflow to sustain its operations.

A3 SEASONALITY OR CYCLICALITY OF OPERATIONS

The business of the Group is such that some of its products, particularly those relating to digital equipments are subject to seasonal variations. Demand for these products tends to increase in the second half of the year. However, it is pertinent to note that the demand of the Group's products are also dependent on the actual overall global economic environment; and the turnaround time of product delivery. Further explanation notes are disclosed in Note B1.

A4 ITEMS OF UNUSUAL NATURE AND AMOUNT

During the current quarter under review, save as disclosed below, there were no items or events that arose, which affected the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows that are unusual by reasons of their nature, size or incidence.

A5 CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no estimates changes of amounts required in the prior interim periods of the current financial year or prior financial years that have a material effect in the current quarter under review.

B1 REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

For the financial period ended 30 June 2013, the Group recorded revenue of RM27,566,057 and profit before taxation of RM725,108 as compared to its preceding year's corresponding period revenue of RM26,650,224 and loss before tax amount of RM987,367. The Group recorded an increase in revenue of approximately 3% In the period ended 30 June 2013 as compared to the corresponding period ended 30 June 2012.

The Group recorded more favourable margin from 22.0% in period ended 30 June 2012 to 25.6% for period ended 30 June 2013 due to favourable input cost as well as higher efficiency in production.

The Group recorded an unrealised forex gain of RM147k for period ended 30 June 2012, compared to unrealised forex gain of RM109k in the current period ended 30 June 2013. The Group recorded a realised forex loss of RM270k in period ended 30 June 2012, compared to realised forex gain of RM15k for the current period ended 30 June 2013; which was mainly due to the USD versus RM.

During the current quarter ended 30 June 2013, our subsidiary in China had made a 50% allowance for impairment of investment in associate RCJ amounting to RMB50k (approximately RM25k), compared to RMB Nil in quarter ended 30 June 2012.

The higher administration expense partly due to the one-off expense amounted to RMB738k (approximately RM369k) of which RMB388k paid in order to secure long-term commitment from existing key employees, and remaining amount of RMB350k for payment to restrain of trade for a former key employee, which were incurred in quarter ended 31 March 2013.

Furthermore, our subsidiary in Singapore had made a reversal of Impairment from other receivables of approximately USD50k (approximately RM155k) when payments were received in the current period ended 30 June 2013. There was no reversal of impairment from other receivables for the period ended 30 June 2012.

The higher finance costs for period ended 30 June 2012 was mainly due to factoring interest charges incurred by our subsidiary in US, which amounted to an average of US\$12k per month, as compared to US\$ Nil for period ended 30 June 2013. This factoring facility was terminated in September 2012.

B2 COMPARISON WITH PRECEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS

For the current quarter ended 30 June 2013, the Group recorded a revenue of RM14,170,280 and a profit before tax of RM1,129,407 as compared to a revenue and loss before tax amount of RM13,395,777 and RM404,299 respectively for the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2013. The Group recorded an increase in revenue of approximately 6% in the second quarter of 30 June 2013 as compared to the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2013.

During the current quarter ended 30 June 2013, our subsidiary in Singapore had made a reversal of impairment from other receivables of approximately USD9k (i.e. RM30k) when payments were received in the current quarter ended 30 June 2013. In comparison to the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2013, our Singapore subsidiary made reversal of impairment from other receivables of approximately US\$40k (i.e. RM126k).

During the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2013, our subsidiary in China incurred a one-off expense amounted to RMB738k (approximately RM389k) of which RMB388k paid in order to secure long-term commitment from existing key employees, and remaining amount of RMB350k for payment to restrain of trade for a former key employee. These expenses were recorded in administrative expense. However, there was no such expense incurred in the current quarter.

B3 PROSPECTS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2013

Looking ahead into the remaining period of 2013, global economic conditions remain uncertain and weaker-than-expected macro situation may drag down global demand of electronics and consumables and continue to affect the electronics and consumables ecosystem. As the market uncertainties continue to overshadow the Euro zone debt crisis and its contagious effect on the global economy, the Board remains cautious on the outlook for 2013.

However, the Board believes that there are opportunities arising from our geographical positioning and technological capabilities, given that emerging markets such as China, India, Latin America and ASEAN continue to drive global demand. Likewise, management is proactively mitigating the escalating labour costs in China, as shown in the improvement of gross margin during the quarter.

As such, the Board Is of the view that notwithstanding the competitive business environment, we are optimistic that the financial performance for 2013 will be better than the preceding year due to the current measures taken by management to reduce costs and expand sales.
