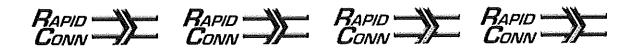

NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2013

A EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS ("FRS") 134 INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

A1 BASIS OF PREPARATION

The unaudited Interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with MFRS134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Rule 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") for the ACE Market.

The unaudited interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to the understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation applied in the unaudited interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted in the most recent annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012.

A2 AUDIT REPORT OF THE PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

There were no audit qualification on the financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 other than an audit emphasis of matter by the independent auditor as follows:

Rapid Conn Interconnect (M) Sdn. Bhd.'s auditor's report contain the audit emphasis of matter relating to the appropriateness of going concern basis of accounting is dependent on the success of the future operations and financial support from its holding Company and its fellow subsidiaries and/or its attaining sufficient cash inflow to sustain its operations.

A3 SEASONALITY OR CYCLICALITY OF OPERATIONS

The business of the Group is such that some of its products, particularly those relating to digital equipments are subject to seasonal variations. Demand for these products tends to increase in the second half of the year. However, it is pertinent to note that the demand of the Group's products are also dependent on the actual overall global economic environment; and the turnaround time of product delivery. Further explanation notes are disclosed in Note B1.

A4 ITEMS OF UNUSUAL NATURE AND AMOUNT

During the current quarter under review, save as disclosed below, there were no items or events that arose, which affected the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows that are unusual by reasons of their nature, size or incidence.

B1 REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

For the financial period ended 30 September 2013, the Group recorded revenue of RM39,728,395 and profit before taxation of RM665,517 as compared to its preceding year's corresponding period revenue of RM40,644,054 and loss before tax amount of RM1,157,059. The Group recorded a decrease in revenue of approximately 2% in the period ended 30 September 2013 as compared to the corresponding period ended 30 September 2012.

The Group recorded more favourable margin from 21.2% in period ended 30 September 2012 to 25.2% for period ended 30 September 2013.

The Group recorded an unrealised forex loss of RM76k for period ended 30 September 2012, compared to unrealised forex gain of RM326k in the current period ended 30 September 2013. The Group recorded a realised forex gain of RM170k in period ended 30 September 2012, compared to realised forex loss of RM20k for the current period ended 30 September 2013; which was mainly due to the USD versus RM.

Our subsidiary in Singapore had made a reversal of impairment from other receivables of approximately USD50k (approximately RM144k) when payments were received in the preceding period ended 30 June 2013. There was no reversal of impairment from other receivables for the period ended 30 September 2012.

The higher finance cost for period added 30 September 2012, was mainly due to factoring interest charges incurred by our subsidiary in US, which amounted to an average of USD12k per month, as compared to USD Nil for period ended 30 September 2013. Thus factoring facility was terminated in September 2012.

B2 COMPARISON WITH PRECEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS

For the current quarter ended 30 September 2013, the Group recorded a revenue of RM12,162,338 and a loss before tax of RM59,591 as compared to a revenue and profit before tax amount of RM14,170,280 and RM1,129,407 respectively for the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2013. The Group recorded a decrease in revenue of approximately 14% in the third quarter of 30 September 2013 as compared to the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2013.

During the current quarter ended 30 September 2013, the Company has wound up Distinctive Rapid Development Son Bhd and approximately RM11k bad debt written off.

Our subsidiary in Singapore had made a reversal of impairment from other receivables amounting to USD 9k in preceding quarter. There was no reversal of impairment from other receivables for the period ended September 2013.

B3 PROSPECTS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2013

Looking ahead into the remaining period of 2013, global economic conditions remain uncertain and weaker-than-expected macro situation may drag down global demand of electronics and consumables and continue to affect the electronics and consumables ecosystem. As the market uncertainties continue to overshadow the Euro zone debt crisis and its contagious effect on the global economy, the Board remains cautious on the outlook for 2013.

However, the Board believes that there are opportunities arising from our geographical positioning and technological capabilities, given that emerging markets such as China, India, Latin America and ASEAN continue to drive global demand. Likewise, management is proactively mitigating the escalating labour costs in China, as shown in the improvement of gross margin during the quarter.

As such, the Board is of the view that notwithstanding the competitive business environment, we are optimistic that the financial performance for 2013 will be better than the preceding year due to the current measures taken by management to reduce costs and expand sales.
