A EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS ("MFRS) 134 INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report of the Group is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134, Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standard Board ("MASB") and Rule 9.22 of the ACE Market Listing Requirements ("Listing Requirements").

1 Review of Performance (Cont'd)

(a) Performance of the current quarter against the preceding year corresponding quarter

The Group recorded revenue of RM24.404 million and loss before tax of RM5.426 million as compared to revenue of RM25.035 million and loss before tax of RM2.733 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2022. The performance of the respective operating business segments is analysed below:

1. Manufacturing

The manufacturing segment's revenue decreased by RM0.430 million to RM23.055 million, as compared with RM23.485 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2022. The decrease was mainly attributed to lower selling price in the current quarter.

During the quarter under review, this sector posted a loss before tax of RM2.530 million compared to RM1.652 million loss before tax in the previous corresponding quarter. The segment registered a higher loss in tandem with the drop in revenue and a rise in administrative expenses.

2. Investment holdings and others

The renewable energy segment recorded a revenue of RM1.349 million during the period under review compared to RM1.550 million in the corresponding quarter of 2022. The revenue was contributed from the biogas plant for the sale of electricity to TNB.

The investment holdings and other sectors recorded a loss before tax of RM2.896 million as compared to a loss before tax of RM1.081 million in the corresponding quarter of 2022. This was mainly due to impairment loss on development costs.



1 Review of Performance (Cont'd)

(b) Performance of the current cumulative period against previous year cumulative period

The Group recorded revenue of RM81.134 million and loss before tax of RM5.199 million as compared to revenue of RM72.193 million and loss before tax of RM4.811 million recorded in the corresponding cumulative period 2022. The performance of the respective operating business segments is analysed below:

1. Manufacturing

The manufacturing segment's revenue increased by RM9.476 million to RM77.121 million, as compared with RM67.645 million recorded in the corresponding cumulative period of 2022. The increase was mainly attributed to the higher sales volume in the current cumulative period.

During the period under review, this sector posted a loss before tax of RM5.837 million compared to RM2.924 million loss before tax in the previous corresponding period. This was mainly due to lower average selling price and higher production costs.

2. Investment holdings and others

The renewable energy segment recorded a revenue of RM4.013 million during the period under review compared to RM4.548 million in the corresponding cumulative quarter of 2022. The revenue was contributed from the biogas plant for the sale of electricity to TNB.

The investment holdings and other sectors recorded a profit before tax of RM0.638 million as compared to a loss before tax of RM1.887 million in the corresponding cumulative 2022. Profit before tax in the current cumulative period mainly due to a gain on disposal of an associate and a loss from impairment of development costs.

4 Business Prospects

The Group is primarily engaged in manufacturing of cast acrylic sheets. Cast acrylic sheets are used widely in sanitary wares, signage & displays, architectural designs, interior design, automotive & transportation, and other applications. Other applications include food, medical, industrial equipment, and sports. According to research, the global cast acrylic sheet market is expected to grow 5% to 6% annually. The demand for cast acrylic sheet will continue to see a gradual recovery from both emerging and developed economies.

The Group has introduced an eco-friendly cell-cast acrylic, a-castGreen readily replaces and is suitable for use in a broad range of indoor and outdoor applications. Its characteristics are comparable to virgin monomer produced acrylic especially in key areas such as light transmittance, surface characteristics, durable and easy fabrication, and machining.



4 Business Prospects (Cont'd)

The Group has also set up a joint venture company, Asia Poly Worldbizz Sdn. Bhd. which specialise in design, supply, fabrication (including thermoforming and on-site chemical bonding) and installation of acrylic panels.

The Management is optimistic that, these will drive the growth of the Group moving forward.

5 Profit Forecast, Profit Guarantee and Internal Targets

The Group did not provide any profit forecast, profit guarantee and internal targets in any public document or any announcement made.

6 Taxation

Income tax on the profit for the period comprise of deferred tax.
