Technical Definitions

- Cavitation** : Cavitation refers to the formation of very small vacuum bubbles in a liquid medium through which ultrasonic waves are being passed, whose subsequent rapid collapse and implosion leads to the release of a relatively large amount of energy, and hence cleaning power, in a relatively small area.
- Clean Room Class N** : Clean Room classification whereby there are no more than N particles equal to or greater than 0.5 micron in size in one cubic foot of air. Common classifications are Clean Room Class 1, Class 10, Class 100 and Class 1,000. Although Class 10,000 and 100,000 also exist, the relatively high level particle count means that these specifications more closely resemble a clean environment rather than a Clean Room.
- Cleaning Technology** : Technology utilised to remove contaminants from an Object. Cleaning technologies include ultrasonic cleaning, vapour cleaning, wet or dry brush cleaning, agitation cleaning, differential temperature cleaning, air blowing, high-pressure water spraying, and laser cleaning.
- Contaminant** : Any substance whose presence is detrimental in any way to an Object. Contaminants typically found in a manufacturing environment include grease, metal chips, loose fibres, and other particles. It is usually impossible or impractical to remove all the contaminants from an Object. As such, Precision Cleaning is often carried out to meet or exceed certain defined specifications.
- Design** : Incorporates system design, engineering design and specifications, software design and specifications, material specifications, and functional specifications. Engineering design and specifications are primarily defined in terms of cleanliness level desired. The characteristics of the object to be cleaned may also influence system and engineering design.
- Industrial Cleaning** : A general term describing a task or set of tasks performed by machine to remove Contaminants from manufactured Objects as part of the manufacturing process. Industrial Cleaning is characterised by the consistent cleaning of a relatively large number of objects. Contaminants cleaned are generally visible to the human eye. Industrial Cleaning cleanliness requirements are generally not as stringent in terms of contaminant size, contaminant count or object fragility as those that require Precision Cleaning. Industrial Cleaning generally does not require a controlled environment.
- N Micron Cleanliness** : A measure of a Precision Cleaning System's cleaning power, whereby a Precision Cleaning System of N Micron Cleanliness is able to remove contaminant particles of at least Nano (N) micron size from an Object. Common cleanliness standards are 1 micron and 10 micron.
- Object** : The term "Object" may refer to any item that is the subject of a Precision Cleaning process. A very wide range of items may be described as such. Objects may include, finished or semi-finished electronic components; semi-conductor wafers; optical lenses of glass, plastic or other material; wafer boats (a device used to store and transport semiconductor wafers); and stamped or machined metal parts.
- Particle Count** : As a measure of an Precision Cleaning System's cleaning power, Particle Count quantifies the number of Contaminant particles of at least a defined size on an Object.

DEFINITIONS (Cont'd)

- Precision Cleaning : A term describing a task or set of tasks performed by machine to remove minute Contaminants from manufactured Objects as part of the manufacturing process. Precision Cleaning is characterised by the consistent cleaning of a relatively large number of objects. Objects to be cleaned are sometimes delicate, requiring special handling and cleaning processes. Contaminants are normally minute and range in size down to the sub-micron level. Precision Cleaning is typically carried out in a controlled environment, such as a Clean Room, so as to reduce contamination by Contaminants present in the environment.
- Precision System Cleaning : A set of machinery and equipment integrated to perform Precision Cleaning on an Object. One or more precision cleaning technologies may be utilised to clean an Object. The set of cleaning machinery and equipment may integrate pre and post cleaning systems and machinery for, among others, rinsing or drying the Object. The Precision Cleaning System may be fully automated, semi-automated or manually operated.
- Precision Cleaning Ultrasonic : A Precision Cleaning Technology that utilises high-frequency sound waves, beyond the range of human hearing (i.e. above 20 kHz), to remove contaminants from Objects.
- Sound waves are transmitted from an ultrasonic transducer/diaphragm to the Objects via a liquid medium, which may be an aqueous solution (for example, water or detergent), or an organic solvent.
- Specifications : Precision cleaning Specifications are criteria established by customers that customers require cleaning systems to meet. Specifications are primarily defined in terms of the maximum allowable particle size remaining on the Object after the cleaning process, and particle count. Damage to the Object due to the cleaning process should be avoided, or at least minimised. Secondary requirements may include throughput rates, cost, and Object moisture levels.
