Part A: Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Financial Reporting Standard 134 ("FRS 134") Interim Financial Reporting

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements are unaudited and had been prepared in accordance with the MFRS 134 —Interim Financial Reporting issued by Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) and Rule 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa Securities) for the ACE Market and should be read in conjunction with the audited statutory financial statements presented for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

2. AUDITORS' REPORT ON PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The audited financial statements of the preceding financial year were not subjected to any qualification.

3. COMMENTS ABOUT SEASONAL OR CYCLICAL FACTORS

The Group's business, being predominantly export in nature and caters largely for the consumer electronics market, is subject to seasonal fluctuations. Business in the second half of the year is normally stronger than the first half of the year due to surge in consumer demand during Christmas and New Year seasons overseas.

4. UNUSUAL ITEM DUE TO THEIR NATURE, SIZE OR INCIDENCE

During the quarter under review, there were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows to the effect that is unusual in nature, size or incidence.

5. MATERIAL ESTIMATES AND CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no changes in estimates that have had any material effect on the financial year-to-date results.

6. ISSUANCE OR REPAYMENT OF DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuances, repurchases and repayments of debt securities during the period under review and up to the date of this report.

14. SUBSEQUENT EVENT

There are no subsequent events which have a material impact on the financial statements under review.

15. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

(a) Current quarter compared to the corresponding quarter of last year (1Q13 vs 1Q12)

For the first quarter ended 31 March 2013, the Group achieved sales revenue of RM 36.1 million as compared to sales revenue of RM35.9 million for the corresponding quarter last year. The mobile phone accessories, electronic headlamps, floor-care products and other consumer electronic products recorded gains. However, these gains were mainly off-set by the decreased household appliances' wire-harness system business with last time buy as the Group had decided to exit from this business as it was not profitable and also a shortfall in meeting the demand in network cameras due to a delay in the supply of incoming parts to complete the assembly which has since been resolved. Overall, the Group still managed to register an approximately 1% sales growth, comparing this quarter against the same quarter last year.

15. PERFORMANCE REVIEW(cont'd)

(a) Current quarter compared to the corresponding quarter of last year (1Q13 vs 1Q12)

The Group registered a loss attributable to equity holders of the parent company of RM 5.6million as compared to a profit of RM 0.6 million for the corresponding quarter last year. The loss was mainly attributed to the household appliances' wireharness system business which was not profitable, therefore, had decided to exit from this business segment and the discontinuation of specific consumer electronic products, thereby, resulting in margin compression. With this decision to exit from the household appliances' wire harness system business, the Group would be able to move forward positively. Furthermore, the discontinuation of specific consumer electronic products with new replacement models would augur well for the Group in the long term, as the selling prices for these products would be reinitialized with higher margin.

(b) Current quarter versus the preceding quarter (1Q13 vs 4Q12)

Sales revenue for the first quarter ended 31 March 2013 at RM 36.1 million was 8% lower than the preceding quarter of RM 39.4 million. The decrease was expected as demand normally eased after the year end festive period. In any event, there was notable strength in the sales of mobile phone accessories for the quarter concerned.

The Group registered loss attributable to equity holders of the parent company of RM 5.6 million as compared to loss attributable to equity holders of the parent company of RM 4.5 million in the preceding quarter. The higher loss was mainly attributed to the exiting from the household appliances' wire-harness system business and the discontinuation of specific consumer electronic products which resulted in margin compression.

16. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS AND TARGETS

Despite the continuing weakness in the Eurozone economy, the uncertainties in the US economy and a soft economy in China, the Group registered sustainable sales revenue of RM 36.1 million for the first quarter ended 31 March 2013. Sales is expected to grow, inspite of exiting from the household appliances' wire-harness system business, as it would be compensated by the increase in business from the core business segments; namely; mobile phone accessories, computer peripherals and the consumer electronics sectors which are expected to be sustainable and vibrant as the Group is in niche markets in these sectors. The exiting from the household appliances' wire-harness system business bodes positively for the financials of the Group as it would not be required to carry the burden of the loss from this business segment moving forward. The Group would continue its strategy of phasing out long running products with low margin and replacing them with more innovative products with higher margin.

It will also forge ahead with pitching for business in the medical/healthcare and automotive segments. In this regard, the Group has in May 2013 been certified with TS 16949, implying that we are ready and qualified to take business from the automotive OEMs or its Tier 1 suppliers.

The implementation of the minimum wage policy at the beginning of 2013 increased our cost of production. We have cushioned this adverse impact to some extent and expect to further mitigate it by continuously re-designing our processes for semi-automation or full automation, simplifying the processes and reviewing ways to further improve productivity.

We expect the insurance claim for the fire mishap which happened in April 2012 to be finalized by the end of the second quarter of 2013. With the preceding insurance finalization and having taken the above crucial steps of exiting from non-profitable household appliances' wire-harness system business, the discontinuation of specific consumer electronic products with the replacement with new models, hence higher margin and focusing in reducing costs and improving productivity, we are expecting to turnaround as we march forward in 2013.

17. INCOME TAX EXPENSE

Income tax is calculated at the Malaysian statutory tax rate of 25% of the estimated assessable profit for the year.

There is provision of taxation in respect of a subsidiary company on its other income and there is no provision for subsidiaries that have available unabsorbed business losses or with tax exemption status.

18. SALES OF UNQUOTED SECURITIES AND PROPERTIES

There were no purchases or disposal of unquoted securities during the quarter and financial year to-date. The Group has not disposed off any properties for the current quarter and financial year-to-date.

19. QUOTED SECURITIES

There were no purchases or disposal of quoted securities during the financial quarter under review.

20. CORPORATE PROPOSALS

To-date, we have completed the planned utilization of all proceeds, totaling approximately RM 6.9 million raised from the Private Placement of 32,689,200 new K-One shares which was listed and quoted on the ACE Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Bhd. on 2 May 2012.

There are no corporate proposals announced but not completed as at the reporting date.
