Part A: Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Financial Reporting Standard 134 ("FRS 134") Interim Financial Reporting

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements are unaudited and had been prepared in accordance with the MFRS 134 —Interim Financial Reporting issued by Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) and Rule 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa Securities) for the ACE Market and should be read in conjunction with the audited statutory financial statements presented for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

2. AUDITORS' REPORT ON PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The audited financial statements of the preceding financial year were not subjected to any qualification.

3. COMMENTS ABOUT SEASONAL OR CYCLICAL FACTORS

The Group's business, being predominantly export in nature and caters largely for the consumer electronics market, is subject to seasonal fluctuations. Business in the second half of the year is normally stronger than the first half of the year due to surge in consumer demand during Christmas and New Year seasons overseas.

4. UNUSUAL ITEM DUE TO THEIR NATURE, SIZE OR INCIDENCE

During the quarter under review, there were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows to the effect that is unusual in nature, size or incidence.

5. MATERIAL ESTIMATES AND CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no changes in estimates that have had any material effect on the financial year-to-date results.

6. ISSUANCE OR REPAYMENT OF DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuances, repurchases and repayments of debt securities during the period under review and up to the date of this report.

7. DIVIDENDS PAID

For the quarter under review, there were no dividends declared.

13. CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

There were no material capital commitments for the period under review.

14. SUBSEQUENT EVENT

There are no subsequent events which have a material impact on the financial statements under review.

15. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

(a) Current quarter compared to the corresponding quarter of last year (2Q13 vs 2Q12)

For the second quarter ended 30 June 2013, the Group achieved sales revenue of RM 35.7 million as compared to sales revenue of RM 38.2 million for the corresponding quarter last year. The decline in sales of approximately 7% was mainly attributed to the decision made earlier to divest from the unprofitable household appliances' wire-harness system business which effected its full impact in the second quarter of 2013 as this business was halted and the reduced demand for electronic headlamps as it transitioned to new models in the ensuing quarters. Nevertheless, overall total sales from the core businesses of mobile phone accessories, network cameras and consumer technology products increased, comparing the second quarter of 2013 against the corresponding same quarter of 2012.

15. PERFORMANCE REVIEW(cont'd)

(a) Current quarter compared to the corresponding quarter of last year (2Q13 vs 2Q12)

The Group registered profit attributable to equity holders of the parent company of RM 3.4 million as compared to a loss of RM 8.2 million for the corresponding quarter last year. The profit was mainly attributed to the reimbursement of insurance claim amounting to RM 3.3 million relating to the fire mishap which happened in 2012. From the operation aspect, the Group registered a profit of approximately RM 0.1 million. Therefore, the divestment from unprofitable businesses was a step in the right direction.

(b) Current quarter versus the preceding quarter (2Q13 vs 1Q13)

Sales revenue for the second quarter ended 30 June 2013 at RM 35.7 million was 1% lower than the preceding quarter of RM 36.1 million. The marginal decrease was due to the transition to new models for mobile phone accessories and electronic headlamps respectively, therefore causing reduced demand for the second quarter of 2013. Furthermore, following the last buy for the household appliances' wireharness system business in the first quarter of 2013, the preceding business was stopped in the second quarter of 2013. This also contributed to the marginal decrease, comparing the second quarter to the first quarter of 2013. .

The Group registered profit attributable to equity holders of the parent company of RM 3.4 million as compared to a loss attributable to equity holders of the parent company of RM 5.6 million in the preceding quarter. Although the turnaround was mainly attributed to the insurance reimbursement of approximately RM 3.3 million, it is notable that the operational financial performance had improved to become profitable following the final divestment from the unprofitable household appliances wire-harness system business.

16. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS AND TARGETS

The Eurozone recession persists and the region's economy is struggling. The US economy continues to be uncertain while China, the second largest economy in the world remains lack-lustre. Nonetheless, the Group registered sustainable sales of RM 71.8 million in the first half of 2013 against sales of RM 74.1 million for the same period last year (2012). The marginal decrease of 3% was mainly attributed to the loss in sales due to the divestment from the unprofitable household appliances wire-harness system business. In fact, the Group's core businesses of mobile phone accessories, computer peripherals and consumer technology products recorded an overall total increase in business. However, it was insufficient to off-set the decrease caused by the loss in sales resulting from the exit from the household appliances wire-harness business, comparing the first half of 2013 against the same of 2012.

For the second half of 2013, the Group expects the sales momentum of its core businesses of mobile phone accessories, computer peripherals and consumer technology products to intensify based upon two key reasons. Firstly, sales for the second half of the year has normally been much higher than the first as the Group is required to meet increased demand during the year end festive seasons overseas. Secondly, the Group is preparing and anticipating the launch of new models for existing and new customers which is expected to increase sales in the second half of 2013.

The Group would continue to exercise prudence in mitigating currency fluctuations, conducting materials cost reduction, improvement of productivity and controlling of expenses/overheads, all with the aim of sustaining and enhancing the profitability turnaround.

17. INCOME TAX EXPENSE

Income tax is calculated at the Malaysian statutory tax rate of 25% of the estimated assessable profit for the year.

There is provision of taxation in respect of a subsidiary company on its other income and there is no provision for subsidiaries that have available unabsorbed business losses or with tax exemption status.

18. SALES OF UNQUOTED SECURITIES AND PROPERTIES

There were no purchases or disposal of unquoted securities during the quarter and financial year to-date.

The Group has disposed off its factory, comprising of 3 individual lots located in Sungai Petani for a total of RM 1.9 million for the current quarter and financial year-to-date. The net carrying value of the said property was RM 1.56 million.

19. QUOTED SECURITIES

There were no purchases or disposal of quoted securities during the financial quarter under review.

20. CORPORATE PROPOSALS

There are no corporate proposals announced but not completed as at the reporting date.
