NOTES TO THE UNAUDITED INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE FIRST QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2013

PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES ON COMPLIANCE WITH MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING

A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements of the Group are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard ("MFRS") 134, Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 30 June 2013.

The Group has adopted the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") framework issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") commencing on 1 July 2012. This MFRS framework was introduced by the MASB in order to converge Malaysia's existing Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") framework with the International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") framework issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in these quarterly financial statements are consistent with those adopted in the most recent annual audited financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2013 except for the adoption of the new MFRS framework.

The Group has applied MFRS 1 First-time Adoption of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards in preparing the first MFRS framework interim financial report. In preparing this interim financial report, the Group's opening statement of financial position was prepared as at 1 July 2011 which is the Group's date of transition to MFRSs. The transition to the MFRS Framework did not have any material impact on the financial statements of the Group.

PART B – EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO RULE 9.22 OF THE LISTING REQUIRMENTS OF BURSA SECURITIES FOR THE ACE MARKET

B1. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

The Group generated revenue of approximately RM6.31 million for the current quarter under review, representing a 10.92% decrease in comparison to the revenue of approximately RM7.08 million recorded in the preceding year corresponding quarter ("PYCQ"). The Group's lower revenue was mainly due to decrease in overseas sales. The Group achieved a profit before taxation ("PBT") of approximately RM1.62 million for the current quarter ended 30 September 2013 representing a 26.83% decrease compared to PBT of approximately RM2.21 million recorded for the PYCQ. The decrease in PBT was mainly due to decrease in overseas sales.

B2. COMPARISON WITH PRECEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS

The Group's revenue for the current quarter under review of approximately RM6.31 million was lower as compared to approximately RM6.92 million achieved in the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2013, representing a decrease of about RM0.61 million or 8.75%. However, the Group recorded a profit before tax of RM1.62 million for the current quarter ended 30 September 2013 as compared to a PBT of RM0.62 million in the preceding quarter. The increase in PBT was mainly due to lower cost of sale.

B3. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS

In line with the expected continued growth of the Malaysian economy and the prospects of increasing business opportunities arising from various Government and private initiatives, we believe that the Group will positively maintain its position with a positive demand in the local and overseas market.

B4. PROFIT FORECAST AND PROFIT GUARANTEE

Not applicable as the Company has not issued any profit forecast or profit guarantee.
