1. Accounting Policies

The interim financial report is unaudited and is prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard (FRS) 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") for the MESDAQ Market.

The interim condensed financial statements have been prepared based on accounting policies and methods of computation which are consistent with those adopted in the preparation of the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 October 2006 except as disclosed per Note 2.

2. Change in Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 October 2006 except for the adoption of the following new/revised Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") effective for the financial period beginning 1 November 2006:

2. Change in Accounting Policies (Cont'd)

The adoption of the above new/revised FRS does not have significant financial impact on the Group except as disclosed below:

(a) FRS 2: Share-based payment

This FRS requires an entity to recognise share-based payment transactions in its financial statements, including transactions with employees or other parties to be settled in cash, other assets, or equity instruments of the entity.

The Company operates an equity-settled, share-based compensation plan for the employees of the Group. Prior to 1 November 2006, no compensation expense was recognised in profit or loss for share options granted. With the adoption of FRS 2, the compensation expense relating to share options is recognised in profit or loss over the vesting periods of the grants with a corresponding increase in equity. The total amount to be recognised as compensation expense is determined by reference to the fair value of the share options at the date of the grant and the number of share options to be vested by vesting date. The fair value of the share option is computed using Black Scholes model. At every balance sheet date, the Group revises its estimates of the number of share options that are expected to vest by the vesting date. Any revision of this estimate is included in profit or loss and a corresponding adjustment to equity over the remaining vesting period.

Under the transitional provisions of FRS 2, this FRS must be applied to share options that were granted after 31 December 2004 and had not yet vested on 1 January 2006. The application is retrospective and accordingly, the comparative amounts as at 31 October 2006 are restated and the opening balance of retained earnings as at 1 November 2006 has been adjusted. The financial impact to the Group arising from this change in accounting policy is as follows:

(b) FRS 117: Leases

The adoption of the revised FRS 117 has affected the presentation of leasehold land in the financial statement. Under FRS 117, lease is defined as an agreement whereby the lessor conveys to the lessee in return for a payment or series of payments the right to use an asset for an agreed period of time and operating lease is defined as a lease other than lease that transfers substantially all the risks and awards incidental to the ownership of an asset. The lease payment under the operating lease shall be recognised as expense on the straight-line basis over the lease term. Where an entity has previously recognized lease payment of operating lease as property within its property, plant and equipment, the entity shall reclassify such lease payment as prepaid lease payment.

4. Seasonal or cyclicality of interim operations

Presently, the Group focuses its range of products and services to customers/endusers principally engaged in test/backend of semiconductor manufacturing. As such, the Group's performance will inevitably depend heavily on the outlook and cyclical nature of the semiconductor and semiconductor equipment industry which is highly unpredictable and sensitive in nature. Furthermore, semiconductor and semiconductor equipment industry displayed seasonal pattern which was historically experiencing slowdown in activities in the first half of the Group's financial year post festive seasons and regained its momentum and peaked in the second half of the Group's financial year in preparation for the coming festive seasons.

5. Unusual Items Due to Their Nature, Size or Incidence

There were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that were unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence during the financial year to date ended 31 July 2007.

14. Performance Review

The Group posted a higher revenue of RM 2,983,842 in the current quarter ended 31 July 2007, an increase of RM 1,517,491 or 103% from the previous corresponding year quarter ended 31 July 2006. The substantial increase in the revenue was mainly due to customers' acceptance of higher quantity of Tape and Reel systems in the current quarter as compared to the previous corresponding year quarter. The Group's revenue recognition for equipment was based on customers' acceptance instead of delivery made.

With higher revenue generated, the Group posted a profit before taxation during the current quarter ended 31 July 2007 of RM 292,439 as compared to a loss before taxation of RM 212,847 during the previous corresponding year quarter ended 31 July 2006 despite higher administrative expenses and sales and distribution expenses, incurred in the current quarter.

The Group posted a higher revenue of RM 5,774,762 in the current financial year to date ended 31 July 2007, an increase of RM 903,410 or 19% from the previous corresponding financial year to date ended 31 July 2006. The increase in revenue in the current financial year to date was due to higher quantity of Gravity-based Tape and Reel system accepted by the customers as well as the acceptance of the Tray-based Tape and Reel system, which was launched on September 2006.

Despite the higher revenue generated, the Group posted a loss before taxation of RM 183,782 during the current financial year to date ended 31 July 2007 as compared to a profit before taxation of RM 543,315 during the previous corresponding financial year to date ended 31 July 2006. The incurrence of loss before taxation during the current financial year to date was due to lower gross profit margin as a result of strengthening of MYR against USD as well as the increase in fixed overheads mainly due to higher sales and distribution expenses and administration expenses.

15. Commentary on Material Change in Profit/(Loss) before Taxation

As a higher quantity of Tape and Reel systems are accepted by customers during the current quarter ended 31 July 2007 as compared to the previous quarter ended 30 April 2007, the Group posted a higher revenue of RM 2,983,842 as compared to the previous quarter of RM 604,548, an increase of RM 2,379,294 or 394%.

The Group achieved a profit before taxation in the current quarter ended 31 July 2007 of RM 292,439 as compared to a loss before taxation RM 536,806 in the previous quarter due to higher revenue generated during the current quarter despite higher sales and distribution expenses in the current quarter.

16. Commentary on the Prospects

The Group's revenue recognition for machine/system is based on customers' acceptance of the machine/system delivered. As such the revenue and hence, the profit before taxation depend on the success rate and timing of securing the customers' acceptance for the machines/systems delivered.

As at 31 July 2007, approximately 39% of the inventory comprises finished goods that have been consigned for testing and demonstration at the premises of prospective customers pending their acceptance.

With the Group's continuous effort to secure customers' acceptance within the shortest possible period, the Directors are of the opinion that, barring unforeseen circumstances, the Group should be able to post positive result for the full financial year ending 31 October 2007.

17. Profit Forecast and Profit Guarantee

The Group did not issue any profit forecast or profit guarantee in any public document and hence, is not applicable.

18. Qualification of Audit Reports

The audited financial statements of the Company and its subsidiary, VisDynamics Research Sdn Bhd, for the preceding financial years/periods were reported without any qualification.

Under Pioneer Status incentive granted to its subsidiary, 100% of the subsidiary's statutory income from pioneer activities is exempted from income tax for a period of five (5) years, commencing from 1 June 2003. The Pioneer Status may be extended for another five (5) years upon expiry.
