# EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2020

### 1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134, Interim Financial Reporting and the provisions of the Companies Act, 2016, Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia").

The interim financial statements of the Group should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended ("FYE") 31 December 2019. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the charges in the financial position and performance of the Group since the FYE 31 December 2019. The financial statements of the Group for FYE 31 December 2019 are prepared under the historical cost convention unless otherwise indicated in the summary of significant accounting policies.

### 2. Significant Accounting Policies

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this report are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2019.

### 2.1 Adoption of Standards, Amendments and IC Interpretations

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of previous financial year except for the adoption of the following new and amended MFRSs and IC Interpretation which are effective for accounting period beginning on or after 1 January 2020:-

Amendments to References to the Conceptual Framenwork in MFRS Standards Amendments to MFRS 3, Definition of a Business Amendments to MFRS 9, MFRS 139 and MFRS 7, Interest Rate Benchmark Reform Amendments to MFRS 101 and MFRS 108, Definition of Material

### 3. Auditors' Report on preceding annual financial statements

The auditors' reports on the financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the financial year ended 31 December 2019 were not subject to any qualification.

### 4. Seasonality or cyclicality

The Group's operations have not been materially affected by any seasonal/cyclical factors.

### 5. Nature and amount of unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows

There was no item or event that was unusual by reason of its nature, size or incidence during the current quarter which affected the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows of the Group.

### 6. Changes in estimates

There was no material change in the estimates used for the preparation of these interim financial statements.

### 7. Issuances, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities

There was no issuance, cancellation, repurchase, resale and repayment of debt and equity securities during the current quarter under review.

### 8. Valuation of property, plant and equipment

There was no change in the valuation of the property, plant and equipment reported in the previous audited financial statements that would have an effect on the current quarter's financial statements.

### 9. Material events subsequent to the end of the interim period

- 1) On 9 October 2020, the Board of Directors ("Board") of Advance Information Marketing Berhad ("AIM") had announced that AIM proposes to undertake a private placement of up to 20% of the total number of issued shares of AIM to third party investor(s) to be identified later at an issue price to be determined later in accordance with the general mandate pursuant to Sections 75 and 76 of the Companies Act 2016.
- 2) On 14 October 2020, the Board of AIM had announced the receipt of a notice of conditional voluntary take-over offer from Mercury Securities Sdn Bhd, on behalf of Datuk Chai Woon Chet ("the Offeror"), to acquire all the ordinary shares in AIM (excluding treasury shares) which are not held by the Offeror for a cash offer price of RM0.13 per Offer Share.
  - On 19 October 2020, the Board of AIM had announced that M&A Securities Sdn Bhd ("M&A Securities") has been appointed to provide independent advice to the Board and shareholders of AIM on the fairness and reasonableness of the Offer. The Board of AIM will in due course, following consultation with M&A Securities, issue its comments and opinion on the Offer.
  - On 16 November 2020, AIM had announced the circular/notice to shareholders on the independent advice circular.
- 3) The Company together with five other defendants had, on 2 November 2020, been served with a Writ as disclosed in explanatory note 22 to the interim financial statements.

### 10. Change in the composition of the Group

There was no change in the composition of the Group for the quarter under review.

During the quarter ended 30 September 2020, the Group recorded an unaudited revenue of RM2.75 million, as compared to the revenue recorded at RM1.31 million in the corresponding quarter of the preceding year.

The Managed Customer Loyalty Services ("MCLS") segment remained as the major revenue contributor to the Group whereby the segment of MCLS in Indonesia contributed a larger portion compared to MCLS business in Malaysia. The revenue of MCLS business in Indonesia recorded RM2.32 million for the quarter under review as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter's revenue of RM1.15 million which was mainly due to new corporate clients and business.

For the revenue of MCLS segment in Malaysia, RM0.43 million is recorded for the quarter under review as compared to preceding year corresponding quarter's recorded revenue of RM0.16 million. The revenue of the MCLS segment in Malaysia increased due to our major client increasing their orders during the quarter under review.

During the period ended 30 September 2020, the Group recorded an unaudited revenue of RM7.75 million, which increased by 136% as compared to the revenue recorded at RM3.29 million in the corresponding period of the preceding year. The increase in revenue of the Group for the period under review was mainly due to increase in orders from the Group's major clients in our MCLS segment.

The Group's unaudited loss before tax for the quarter and period ended 30 September 2020 recorded at RM0.76 million and RM2.74 million respectively, which had decreased by 6% and 13% respectively as compared to the loss before tax of RM0.80 million and RM3.16 million respectively in the corresponding quarter and period of the preceding year. This was mainly due to increase in gross profit margin and lower operating expenditure in the Group's business operations during the quarter and period under review.

The Group recorded a revenue of RM2.75 million in this quarter which increased by 57% compared to revenue of RM1.76 million in the preceding quarter. The increase in revenue was mainly due to increase in corporate clients' orders in both our Indonesia and Malaysia MCLS's segment.

The Group recorded an unaudited loss before tax of RM0.76 million which decreased by 19% as compared to the unaudited loss before tax of RM0.93 million in the preceding quarter. This was mainly due to increase in the gross profit margin in our Malaysia's MCLS segment and also decrease in the operating expenditure of the Group had in overall decreased the Group's loss before tax of current quarter as compared to the immediate preceding quarter.

### 16. Prospects

The Group's operations for the current quarter continued to be better particularly the marked improvement in the Malaysian fulfillment business despite the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. However, our Indonesian operations were adversely affected when the local authorities implemented a second lockdown. This was further exacerbated whereby four of our local Indonesian staff were tested positive with Covid-19 and hence the closure of our office for quarantine and sanitization for 3 days and other staffs on home quarantine for 14 days.

The Indonesian operations is not expected to be better in the next quarter in view of the ongoing pandemic. Whilst operations has shifted to work from home, the results shall be limited.

The re-implementation of the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Malaysia has further diminished efforts to regain our business footing. Nevertheless, the Group shall continue with the limited movement and resources to enhance the Group's business revenue.

### 17. Profit forecast

The Group did not disclose or announce any profit forecast or profit guarantee in any public document in the financial quarter under review.

### 22. Material litigations

The Company had, on 20 January 2017, been served with a Writ (Kuala Lumpur High Court Suit No.: WA-22NCC-17-01/2-17) issued by Customer Loyalty Solutions Sdn Bhd (in liquidation) ("the Plaintiff", hereby known as "CLS") claiming that the payment of RM6,524,652 from the Plaintiff to the Company are void or voidable. The Claim included two (2) other defendants i.e. a current and a former director of the Company to jointly and severally liable to pay the Plaintiff the sum of RM6,524,652. On 7 July 2011, the Plaintiff ceased as subsidiary of the Company.

The trial was concluded on 16 January 2019. The Court fixed 20 February 2019 for oral submissions and had fixed 4 March 2019 for further submissions. The Court had on 4 March 2019 heard further submissions by the Defendants and then fixed 10 May 2019 for further clarification/decision and it was then postponed to 30 September 2019 for decision.

On 30 September 2019, the Court had dismissed the Plaintiff's claim against all the Defendants with costs of RM15,000 to each Defendant (subject to allocatur fee of 4%). On 29 October 2019, the Plaintiff had filed a Notice of Appeal against the decision of the Kuala Lumpur High Court. The Court of Appeal has fixed the sixth case management on 14 December 2020 pending the grounds of judgement from the Kuala Lumpur High Court.

2) The Company together with five other defendants ("the Defendants"), the current directors and chief executive officer of the Company had, on 2 November 2020, been served with a Writ (Kuala Lumpur High Court suit No.: WA-22NCC-537-11/2020) issued by Mak Siew Wei ("the Plaintiff"), a current executive director of the Company, via its Solicitors, Messrs. Chong + Kheng Hoe. The Plaintiff's suit relates to possible breach of Ace Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad, Malaysian Code on Take-Overs and Mergers 2016, Rule on Take-Overs, Mergers and Compulsory Acquisitions read in conjunction with the Capital Market and Services Act 2007 and the Companies Act, 2016 by the Defendants. On 3 November 2020, the Board of the Company had announced the details related to the Material Litigation.

During the the case management held on 10 November 2020, the Plaintiff sought for an Ad-interim injunction to restrain, inter-alia, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Defendants from being directors or holding office as directors or as the chief executive officer of the Company pending the disposal of this suit. The Judge, however, was not prepared to grant the Plaintiff an Ad-Interim Injunction and fixed on 26 November 2020 at 9:30 a.m. for the hearing of the Plaintiff's application for Interim Injunction.
