EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2022

1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134, Interim Financial Reporting and the provisions of the Companies Act 2016, Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia").

The interim financial statements of the Group should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended ("FYE") 31 December 2021. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the FYE 31 December 2021. The interim financial statements of the Group for financial year ended ("FYE") 31 December 2022 are prepared under the historical cost convention unless otherwise indicated in the summary of significant accounting policies.

2 Significant Accounting Policies

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this report are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Group's audited financial statements for the FYE 31 December 2021.

2.1 Adoption of Standards, Amendments and IC Interpretations

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of previous financial year except for the adoption of the following new and amended MFRSs and IC Interpretation which are effective for accounting period beginning on or after 1 January 2022:-

3. Auditors' Report on preceding annual financial statements

The auditors' reports on the financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the FYE 31 December 2021 were not subject to any qualification.

4. Seasonality or cyclicality

The Group's operations have not been materially affected by any seasonal/cyclical factors.

5. Nature and amount of unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows

There was no item or event that was unusual by reason of its nature, size or incidence during the current quarter which affected the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows of the Group.

6. Changes in estimates

There was no material change in the estimates used for the preparation of these interim financial statements.

7. Issuances, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities

There was no issuance, cancellation, repurchase, resale and repayment of debt and equity securities during the current quarter under review.

8. Valuation of property, plant and equipment

There was no change in the valuation of the property, plant and equipment reported in the previous audited financial statements that would have an effect on the current quarter's financial statements.

9 Significant events during the interim period

On 6 October 2022, AMS entered into a Franchise Agreement with Mediconstant Holding Sdn Bhd ("the Franchisor") for the purpose of obtaining the rights and franchise to operate the business system of the Franchisor in the retailing business of pharmaceutical products and services under the name of "Constant Pharmacy".

On 21 November 2022, the Company announced to undertake Proposed Share Consolidation, Proposed Rights Issue and Proposed Diversification (collectively, the "Proposal"). The application in relation to the Proposal has been submitted to Bursa Securities on 22 November 2022.

10 Material events subsequent to the end of the interim period

On 14 February 2023, the Company announced the implementation of Private Placement ("PP") by fixing the issue price for the first and final tranche of the PP at RM0.0769 per Placement Share ("Issue Price").

The Issue Price is at a discount of RM0.0085 or approximately 9.95% to the 5-day volume weighted average market price of the Company's shares up to and including 13 February 2023 (being the last market day immediately preceding the Price-fixing Date) of RM0.0854 per Company's share.

On 20 February 2023, the Company announced that 26,605,000 units of shares were alloted and issued pursuant to the first and final Tranche of the PP, which marked the completion of the PP. Subsequent to this, the Company's total share capital is 292,663,666 units, amounted to RM30,097,924.

11. Contingent assets and contingent liabilities

There was no contingent asset and contingent liability during the financial quarter under review.

12. Capital commitments

There were no capital commitments since the last audited Statement of Financial Position as at 31 December 2021.

During the quarter and period ended 31 December 2022, the Group recorded an unaudited revenue of RM0.37 million, which had decreased significantly by 60%, as compared to the revenue recorded at RM0.94 million in the corresponding quarter of the preceding year, mainly contributed by segments in Indonesia.

Despite the significant decrease in Managed Customer Loyalty Services ("MCLS") revenue in current period, the segment of MCLS in Indonesia was still the main contributor of the Groups' revenue compared to MCLS business in Malaysia. The revenue of MCLS business in Indonesia had decreased significantly by 78% in current quarter as compared to preceding year corresponding quarter. This was due to change of management team which had caused disruption in the business processes including the absence of projects sales in current quarter.

For the revenue of MCLS segment in Malaysia, RM0.2 million was recorded for the quarter and period under review and it showed an improvement of 26% compared to preceding year corresponding quarter's and period's recorded revenue. This was resulted from the increased in new customers and sales volume.

The Group's unaudited loss before tax for the quarter and period ended 31 December 2022 recorded at RM1.98 million, as compared to the loss before tax recorded at RM2.15 million in the corresponding quarter and period of the preceding year. The slight decrease in loss before tax was mainly due to higher operating expenses incurred in preceding year corresponding quarter such as legal fee on fraud case and loss in derecognising the other investment due to expiry of warrant, which were absence in current quarter under review.

The Group recorded a revenue of RM0.37 million in this quarter which decreased by 16% compared to revenue of RM0.44 million in the preceding quarter which was mainly contributed by the Group's Indonesian subsidiary company as a result of change of management team which led to disruption of business processes in current quarter, as well market turned slow during year end and festive seasons.

The Group recorded an unaudited loss before tax of RM1.98 million as compared to the unaudited loss before tax of RM0.99 million in the preceding quarter. The increased in losses was mainly due to decrease in gross profit of Indonesian's segment to cover the other operating expenses.

16. Prospects

The 4th and final quarter of 2022 continued to be challenging.

The key direction of this quarter involves the commencement of operations of the Company's 1st pharmacy retail outlet chain in Bukit Raja, Klang under the franchisor's brandname CONSTANT during the end of the 4th quarter. The entry of the new business augurs well for the Company thereby reducing reliance of existing MCLS business.

Moving forward to the next quarter, it is hoped that the new pharmacy business to contribute positively to the Group's revenue. Growth in the existing business continue to grow albeit at slower pace. Contributions from Indonesian operations are expected also to grow in 2023. This realignment of business strategies for both the Malaysian and Indonesian operations is now yielding positive results in the near future.

The Group did not disclose or announce any profit forecast or profit guarantee in any public document in the financial quarter under review

The facility was secured by legal charge over the leasehold building of a subsidiary company. The facility was fully settled during current quarter under review.

22. Material litigations

The Company had, on 20 January 2017, been served with a Writ (Kuala Lumpur High Court Suit No.: WA-22NCC-17-01/2017) issued by Customer Loyalty Solutions Sdn Bhd (in liquidation) ("the Plaintiff", hereby known as "CLS") claiming that the payment of RM6,524,652 from the Plaintiff to the Company are void or voidable. The Claim included two (2) other defendants i.e. a current and a former director of the Company to be jointly and severally liable to pay the Plaintiff the sum of RM6,524,652. On 7 July 2011, the Plaintiff was no longer a subsidiary of the Company.

The trial was concluded on 16 January 2019. The Court fixed 20 February 2019 for oral submissions and had fixed 4 March 2019 for further submissions. The Court had on 4 March 2019 heard further submissions by the Defendants and then fixed 10 May 2019 for further clarification/decision and it was then postponed to 30 September 2019 for decision.

On 30 September 2019, the Court dismissed the Plaintiff's claim against all the Defendants with costs of RM15,000 to each Defendant (subject to allocatur fee of 4%). On 29 October 2019, the Plaintiff filed a Notice of Appeal against the decision of the Kuala Lumpur High Court. The Court of Appeal had fixed the next case management on 24 May 2021 pending the grounds of judgment from the Kuala Lumpur High Court.

The Court of Appeal had fixed case management dates on 19 December 2019, 27 February 2020, 29 April 2020, 7 July 2020, 3 September 2020, 8 October 2020, 14 December 2020, 25 February 2021, 24 May 2021, 25 August 2021, 30 November 2021, 27 January 2022, 30 March 2022, 31 May 2022, 5 August 2022, 27 December 2022 and 19 January 2023.

The Court of Appeal has fixed 28 February 2023 to update the status of the Grounds of Judgement, 27 March 2023 to ensure compliance of Court's decisions and 11 April 2023 for hearing of Appeal.
