Notes to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements

1 Basic of preparation

The unaudited interim financial statements have been prepared in compliance with the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the ACE Market and with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) 134 Interim Financial Reporting and with International Accounting Standard (IAS) 34, Interim Financial Reporting and should be read in conjunction with the Group's consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2011.

These notes to interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group for the financial period ended 31 March 2012.

Since the previous annual audited financial statements as at 31 December 2011 were issued, the Group has adopted the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") framework issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") with effect from 1 January 2012. This MFRS framework was introduced by the MASB in order to fully coverage Malaysia's existing Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") framework with the International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") framework issued by the International Accounting Standards Board. Whilst all FRSs issued under the previous FRS framework were equivalent to the MFRSs issued under the MFRS framework, there are some differences in relation to the transitional provisions and effective dates contained in certain of the FRSs. The financial effects of convergence to the MFRS framework and any consequential changes in accounting policies as a result of the convergence are discussed in Note 20.

The Group has early adopted the amendments to MFRS 101, *Presentation of Financial Statements* which is originally effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 July 2012. The early adoption of the amendments to MFRS 101 has no impact on the financial statements other than the presentation format of the statement of comprehensive income.

2 Significant accounting policies

Except as described below, the accounting policies applied by the Group in these condensed consolidated interim financial statements are the same as those applied by the Group in its consolidated annual financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2011.

(a) Property, plant and equipment

Upon transition to MFRS, the Group elected to apply the optional exemption to use the fair value as at 1 January 2012 as deemed cost under MFRSs.

9 Material events subsequent to the end of the interim period

On 23 April 2012, with regards to the proposed acquisition of 51% of Infinite QL Sdn. Bhd., the Company announced that the proposed acquisition will not be proceeding as one of the minority shareholders of Infinite QL Sdn. Bhd. has exercised his pre-emptive right to purchase the shares and hence, the shareholders of Infinite QL Sdn Bhd are not accepting the Company's offer.

On 8 May 2012, the Company received a notification from Mr. Lu Pak Lim (a 30% shareholder of IPSAT Sdn. Bhd.) of his intention to exercise the Put Option on the balance of IPSAT shares not already acquired by the Company as per clause 9.3 sub (1) of the Shareholders Agreement dated 1 December 2009 signed between Mr. Lu Pak Lim and the Company. On 15 May 2012, the Company has agreed to acquire the remaining 300,000 IPSAT Shares held by Mr.Lu Pak Lim, representing 30% of the issued and paid-up capital of IPSAT, at the purchase consideration of RM1,113,178.80 ("Purchase Consideration"). As at todate, the Company is in the process of completing the said purchase.

10 Changes in composition of the Group

There were no changes in composition of the Group during the three months ended 31 March 2012.

11 Changes in contingent liabilities or contingent assets

As at the date of this report, the Group does not have any contingent liabilities or contingent assets.

12 Capital commitments

There were no material commitments for the purchase of property, plant and equipment incurred or known to be incurred for in the current quarter under review.

13 Review of performance

For the first quarter ended 31 March 2012 (1Q12), Privasia group revenue rose by 5.6% to RM10.6 million from RM10.0 million in the same corresponding quarter in the previous year. This was attributed to increased sales in the E-Procurement (E-PROC), Information and Communication Technologies Services (CSERV) and Satellite based network services (SAT).

The Group's PBT was maintained at RM1.1 million for the quarter under review. However, the Group incurred a net loss of RM0.33 million as compared to the net profit RM0.85 million in the same quarter of the previous year, due to current year's income tax expenses as well as deferred tax liabilities.

The current and deferred taxes are due to the expiry of tax exemption benefits for Privasia Sdn Bhd as an MSC-status company on 22 January 2012, as the Group is now required to provide current tax expenses for all its business income which amounted to RM0.72 million for the quarter under review. In addition, the Group has provided for deferred tax liabilities amounting to RM0.72 million, which arose due to the Group's temporary timing difference between the accounting net book value and tax written down value of its qualifying assets, with effect from the expiry date.

The deferred tax liability is expected to reduce over the immediate future as the timing difference between the book value and tax written down value. The liability is a non-cash expense in the income statement.

Comparison with preceding quarter

In comparison with the preceding quarter ended 31 December 2011 (4Q11), revenue in 4Q11 was higher with RM13.8 million versus RM10.6 million in 1Q12 due to higher sales from the Group's E-Procurement services (E-PROC), Information and Communication Technologies Distribution (CDIST) and Satellite based network services (SAT). 1Q12 recorded profit before tax was at RM1.11 million and net loss of RM0.33 million, versus 4Q11's PBT of RM2.32 million and net profit of RM1.97 million.

14 Future prospects

The Group is optimistic about the prospects of the ICT outsourcing industry, in view of the secured order book of RM 167 million which will last till 2020. The Group also recently received a letter of tender acceptance from Melaka ICT Holdings Berhad to install a complete fibre optic network throughout the state. In view of the challenging economic scenario in Malaysia in the near term, the Group will continue to look for more opportunities to continue the Group's growth in the current financial year.

On 21 July 2011, the Group was served with a notice to attend a mention on 15 September 2011 at the Kuala Lumpur Industrial Court for Industrial Court Case No. 14(21)(14)/4-1388/10. The case involves a claim of wrongful dismissal by of a former employee of (then) Airocom Sdn Bhd, and the seeking of reinstatement to his former position / employment with the Company. The matter was referred by the Hon. Minister of Human Resources to the Industrial Court under s.20(3) of the Industrial Relations Act 1967.

The Board is of the view that the Company has reasonable defence against the claim. On 16 November 2011, the Company filed its Statement in Reply to the court and the trial of the matter is fixed on 5 July 2012 and 3 - 4 September 2012, respectively, wherein parties are to file their Witness Statements and any further documents by 5 June 2012.
