2nd Quarter of 2008 vs. 2nd Quarter of 2007

The Group recorded revenue of RM1.958 million for the quarter ended 30 June 2008 ("2Q 2008"), a 83.2% decline compared to RM11.663 million for the corresponding period last year. A slow down in the global economy impacted the overall demand for the Application-Specific-Standard-Product ("ASSP") chips during the first half of the year. Despite the rollout of new chips, the weak business sentiment had caused delay to our customers' product launch which adversely affected the top and bottom line.

The Group reported loss after tax of RM2.893 million for 2Q 2008 as compared with profit after tax of RM2.720 million for the corresponding quarter that has included an exceptional gain of RM0.938 million from disposal of shares in Q1 2007. The loss was mainly due to a drop in revenue for ASSP products and a weak quarter for Electronic Design Automation ("EDA") software sales.

1st half of 2008 vs. 1st half of 2007

The revenue for the first half of 2008 declined by approximately 63.7% to RM7.604 million from RM20.976 million in 2007, which was mainly due to a disappointing 2Q 2008 performance as compared with the previous corresponding period.

Total operating expenses were kept stable and remained the same as compared with the corresponding period despite the fact that the Company has embarked on an expansion strategy, reflecting the management's cautious attitude and keen watch over its operating cost.

B2. Material changes in the quarterly results compared to the results of the immediate preceding quarter

The Group posted revenue and loss after tax of RM1.958 million and RM2.893 million respectively for the current quarter ended 30 June 2008. Compared with the immediate preceding quarter, the Group's revenue decreased by RM3.688 million and the Group's profit after tax decreased by RM2.982 million respectively.

The substantial decrease in profit was mainly due to a sharp decline in ASSP and weaker software distribution revenue.

B3. Business prospects

The Board expects the performance for this year continue to be challenging. However the management is glad to report that the back-end process issues reported earlier which resulted in the delayed ASSP products being on schedule have been resolved. There will also be a new Application-Specific Integrated Circuit ("ASIC") product launch early in Q4 this year, targeting at the emerging and fast growing Light Emitting Diode ("LED") Display panel market.
