A. EXPLANATORY NOTES IN ACCORDANCE WITH FRS 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

The unaudited condensed interim financial statements for the third quarter ended 31 March 2008 have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") No. 134 - Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") for the MESDAQ Market ("MMLR"). The unaudited condensed interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of Sanichi Technology Berhad ("Sanichi" or "the Company") and its subsidiaries (collectively known as "Sanichi Group" or "the Group"), for the financial year ended ("FYE") 30 June 2007.

Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and presentations adopted by the Group for these interim condensed financial statements are consistent with the most recent audited financial statements for the FYE 30 June 2007.

FRS 124 - Related Party Disclosures has been issued and are effective for financial periods beginning on or after 1 October 2006 and will be effective for the Group's financial statements for the financial year ending 30 June 2008.

The following revised FRS have been issued and are effective for financial periods beginning on or after 1 July 2007 and will be effective for the Group's and the Company's financial statements for the financial year ending 30 June 2008:-

During the quarter, there were no issuance and repayment of debts and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellation, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares.

A7. Dividend Paid

During the quarter under review, on 28 January 2008, the Company paid an interim tax exempt dividend of 5% equivalent to 0.5 sen per share for the financial year ending 30 June 2008 to the holders of ordinary shares of Sanichi.

A8. Segmental Reporting

The primary basis of segmental reporting of the Group is by geographical segment. The Group's revenue by geographical market for the quarter ended 31 March 2008 is as follows:-

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A10. Material Events Subsequent to the End of the Quarter under Review

There was no material event subsequent to the end of the quarter under review up to the date of this report which has not been reflected in the financial statements for the quarter under review.

A11. Changes in the Composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the quarter under review.

A12. Changes in Contingent Liabilities or Contingent Assets

There were no changes in contingent liabilities or contingent assets since the last annual balance sheet date up to the date of this report.

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY MMLR (APPENDIX 9B)

B1. Review of Group's Results for the Current Quarter and Year-to-Date Ended 31 March 2008

The Group recorded revenue of RM5.98 million for the quarter and RM18.87 million for the 9 months period ended 31 March 2008. Advance Precision Injection Mould ("APIM") contributed approximately 69.12% of revenue for the 3 months ended 31 March 2008. The Group's profit after tax ("PAT") for the quarter and for the 9 months period ended 31 March 2008 was RM0.12 million and RM1.92 million respectively.

For the current quarter under review, the Group achieved revenue of RM5.98 million representing an increase of RM0.64 million as compared to the corresponding quarter last year. The Group's profit before tax ("PBT") decreased by RM0.40 million to RM0.21 million for the current quarter as compared to RM0.61 million as recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The Group achieved a PBT of RM2.31 million for the 9 months period ended 31 March 2008.

B2. Variation of Results for the Current Quarter Ended 31 March 2008 against Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group recorded a decrease of approximately 10% in its revenue to RM5.98 million in the quarter ended 31 March 2008 against RM6.65 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2007 whilst PBT decreased by approximately 85% to RM0.21 million in the quarter ended 31 March 2008 as compared to RM1.37 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2007.

Revenue decreased by approximately 10% or RM0.67 million, as compared to the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2007, due to slower sales. As a result of the decrease in revenue and higher operating costs due to higher depreciation, salary, marketing expenditure and loss arising from foreign exchange rates, the PBT, as compared to the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2007, has decreased by approximately 85% or RM1.16 million.

B3. Group's Prospects for FYE 2008

Despite the increasing materials costs and challenges in the competitive markets, the Board expects that the performance of the Group will be satisfactory for the financial year ending 30 June 2008.

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B4. Variance of Profit Forecast

The Group did not publish any profit forecast for the period under review.

The effective tax rate of the Group's current tax charge for the period was higher than statutory tax rate mainly due to tax incurred arising from other income, while the tax charge for the 9 months period ended 31 March 2008 was lower than the statutory tax rate mainly due to tax incentives enjoyed by its subsidiary company, Asia Pinnacle Sdn Bhd, which was granted pioneer status.

B6. Profit on Sale of Unquoted Investments and Properties

There was no disposal of unquoted investments and properties during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.

- (i) On 5 December 2007, the Group announced the following corporate proposals:
 - (a) A proposed private placement of up to 11,350,000 new ordinary shares of RM0.10 each in the Company ("Sanichi Shares"), representing up to 10% of the existing issued and paid-up share capital at an issue price to be determined later ("Proposed Private Placement"); and
 - (b) A proposed special issue of up to 53,507,200 Sanichi Shares, representing up to 30% of the enlarged issued and paid-up share capital of the Company, (after the Proposed Private Placement and Proposed Special Issue), at an issue price to be determined later ("Proposed Special Issue").

(hereinafter, the Proposed Private Placement and Proposed Special Issue shall be collectively referred to as the "Proposals")

On 19 February 2008, the Group announced that the Securities Commission ("SC") had, *vide* its letter dated 18 February 2008 approved the Proposals subject to certain terms and conditions.

Further to the above, on 25 March 2008, the Group announced that the Ministry of International Trade and Industry ("MITI") approved the Proposals *vide* its letter dated 25 March 2008 subject to certain terms and conditions.

Apart from the approvals received from SC and MITI, the Proposals are conditional upon the approvals of the following:

- (a) MITI for the recognition of the Bumiputera placees to be identified;
- (b) Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the listing of and quotation for the placement shares and the special issue shares to be issued pursuant to the Proposals; and
- (c) The shareholders of Sanichi at an extraordinary general meeting to be convened;

The Proposals are pending implementation.
