B1 Review Of Performance

For the current financial quarter, the Group recorded revenue of RM11.76 million. This was mainly generated from Technical Security Services which contributed approximately 67% of the total revenue for the current financial quarter.

The Group recorded a profit before taxation amounting to RM1.21 million in the current financial quarter, a decrease in losses of RM3.51million as compared to the preceding year's corresponding financial quarter. This was mainly contributed by the provision for doubtful debt amounted to approximately RM1.70 million and higher administration expenses in preceding year's corresponding quarter.

B2 Comparison With Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group generated revenue of RM11.76 million in the current financial quarter under review. This represents an increase of approximately RM7.19 million or 158% from the revenue of RM4.57 million recorded in the preceding financial quarter. This was mainly attributed by the significant increase in contribution from Technical Security Services section.

The Group recorded a profit before taxation amounting to RM1.21 million in the current financial quarter, an increase in profit by RM0.52 million comparing with the profit before taxation announced in preceding financial quarter. This was mainly as a result of few new projects secured in the Technical Security Sections in the current financial quarter.

B3 Business Prospects

The Group has continuously tendering for various ICT Security projects both locally and overseas. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group expects and has actively positioned ourselves strategically, to secure more contracts in the future.

B4 Variance Of Actual Profit From Forecast Profit

This note is not applicable for the current financial quarter.

B5 Taxation

There was no taxation on operating income during the financial quarter under review due to tax exempt income of the Company pursuant to its pioneer status granted under the Promotion of Investments Act, 1986 (Amendments) pursuant to its MSC status entitlement under the MSC Bill of Guarantees for five years commencing 24 December 2002. The status has been extended for another five(5) years from the date of expiry of the first five(5) years period.

The amount of taxation incurred was contributed by one of the subsidiary companies.

B6 Sale of Properties and Unquoted Investments

There were no sales of unquoted investments and properties during the current financial quarter under review.

 - (c) proposed establishment of an employees' share option scheme involving up to 30% of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company/Newco at any one time ("Proposed ESOS"); and
 - (d) proposed share buy-back of up to a maximum of 10% of the issued and paid-up share capital of the Company/Newco ("Proposed Share Buy-Back").
