Notes To The Interim Financial Report For The Financial Period Ended 30 September 2012

A Explanatory Notes Pursuant To Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of My E.G. Services Bhd and its subsidiaries ("the Group") for the financial year ended 30 June 2012.

These unaudited interim financial statements are the Group's first MFRS condensed consolidated interim financial statements for part of the period covered by the Groups first MFRS annual financial statements for the year ending 30 June 2013. MFRS 1 First-Time Adoption of Malaysia Financial Reporting Standards has been applied. The transition from FRS to MFRS does not have material effects on the financial statements of the Group.

The same accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in these interim financial statements are consistent with the annual financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2012 and application of MFRS are not material to the financial statements of the Group.

A2. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2012 was not qualified.

A3. Seasonal and Cyclical Factors

The Group's business operation result is subject to seasonality factors. The demand for new driving licences generally increases in the first half of the year (i.e the second half of the Group's financial year) due mainly to the long school holidays after the Government exams, where most 16-20 year olds would obtain their driving licences between the months of January to June. Therefore, JPJ-related revenue in the first half of the year (January – June) has historically been approximately 50% higher than the JPJ-related revenue recorded for the second half of the year (July – December).

A4. Unusual Items Affecting Assets, Liabilities, Equity, Net Income or Cash Flow

There were no unusual items affecting the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flow of the Group during the current financial quarter under review, that are unusual by reason of their nature, size or incidence.

A5. Material Changes in Estimates

There were no other changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years, which have a material effect on the current quarter's results.

A6. Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuance and repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-back, share cancellation, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares for the current quarter under review, saved as disclosed below:

- i) On 3 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM58,928 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- ii) On 4 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM58,928 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- iii) On 6 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 18,200 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM11,092 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- iv) On 9 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 200,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM120,516 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- v) On 10 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 9,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM5,448 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- vi) On 11 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM60,438 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- vii) On 13 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM59,935 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- viii) On 18 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM61,445 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.

A6. Debt and Equity Securities (continued)

- ix) On 25 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM63,460 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- x) On 26 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM62,957 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- xi) On 27 July 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM62,453 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.
- xii) On 5 September 2012, the Company had purchased a total of 100,000 of its issued share capital ("MYEG shares") from the open market. The total consideration paid for the share buy-back of MYEG shares, including transaction costs was RM79,789 and was financed from internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.

The total shares bought back for the financial period ended September 30, 2012 amounted to 1,127,200 (2011: 372,000) MYEG shares. As at September 30, 2012 a total of 4,735,600 MYEG shares were retained as treasury shares in the Company. None of the treasury shares held were resold or cancelled during the financial period ended September 30, 2012.

A7. Dividend Paid

No dividends were paid during the current financial quarter under review.

A8. Segmental Information

The Group operates wholly in Malaysia and is principally engaged in the business of development and implementation of E-Government services project and the provision of other related services for the E-Government Initiative which are substantially within a single business segment. As such, the financial information by geographical and industry segments of the Group's operations are not available for presentation.

A9. Valuation of Property, Plant and Equipment

There has been no valuation on any of the Group's property, plant and equipment during the current financial quarter under review.

A10. Subsequent Events

There were no material events subsequent to the end of the current financial quarter under review that has not been reflected.

Explanatory Notes Pursuant To Appendix 9B Of The Listing Requirements Of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

B1. Performance of the Group

The Group posted Revenue and Profit after Taxation ("PAT") of RM16.06 million and RM6.50 million respectively for the first financial quarter ("Q1 FY2013") and year to date period ended 30 September 2012 ("3M FY2013") as compared to RM14.19 million and RM5.38 million respectively in the corresponding quarter ("Q1 FY2012") and year to date period ended 30 September 2011 ("3M FY2012").

The increase of RM1.87 million (13.2%) in Revenue and PAT of RM1.12 million (20.8%) respectively are primarily attributable to the strong growth for our online renewal of insurance and road tax transactions.

For the Quarter under review, the Group's revenue and PAT decreased by RM1.41 million and RM1.56 million respectively as compared to Q4 FY2012. The decrease in revenue and PAT is primarily attributable to seasonality factor where demand for JPJ new licences decreased in Q1 FY2013.

In addition, PAT is also affected by an increase in marketing expenses incurred for creating and promoting the Group's brand name and services.

B3. Prospect of the Group

For the financial year ending 30 June 2013, existing services will continue to contribute to our Group revenue. In addition, the Group will focus on completing the implementation of the online service tax monitoring project. The Group will also increase the adoption of the recently launched online vehicle ownership transfer services as well as new services under the Immigration Department.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Directors of MyEG are of the opinion that the results for the financial year ending 30 June 2013 ("FYE 2013") will continue to be satisfactory as awareness of our existing services and brand name continues to increase while new services would continue to be rolled out in FYE2013.

The effective tax rate for the current financial quarter and cumulative year to date is 0.57% as compared to the statutory tax rate of 25%. The lower effective tax rate is primarily because a significant proportion of the Group's revenue and PBT are mainly contributed by MY EG Sdn Bhd ("EGSB"). As EGSB is a MSC status company, its revenue is not subjected to income tax.
