The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate (IC 15), including its parent, significant investor and venturer ("Transitioning Entities").

The Group and the Company will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2012. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group and the Company will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of the MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening undistributed income.

The adoption of the MFRSs does not have any significant impact on the interim financial statements of the Group and the Company.

During the current quarter under review, the Group has recorded a loss before tax of RM4.1 million on the back of revenue of RM4.19 million representing a significant lower losses as compared to the same period last year of RM9.76 million. The higher losses in the preceding comparative quarter were mainly a result of provisions made to receivable and higher amortization in that reporting quarter.

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The Group recorded a revenue of RM4.19 million and LBT of RM4.1 million in the current quarter as compared to a revenue of RM6.01 million and LBT of RM3.41 million in the immediate preceding quarter. This represents a decrease in revenue of approximately 30.2% and an increase in LBT of 20.4% respectively as compared to preceding quarter. The increase in losses is mainly due to lower revenue recorded in the current quarter.

17. Commentary Of Prospects

The semiconductor outlook for the 2nd half of 2012 remains weak as the year-on-year worldwide sales continue to registering a slight decrease. The decrease was due mainly to lower demand from Europe countries as the crisis deepening.

Key ASIC group revenue has decreased as highlighted in note 16 above as compared to the immediate preceding quarter but the sales of chip as a result from our turnkey projects continue to register growth. The decrease in revenue was due to lower non-recurring engineering fees recorded in the current quarter. The Board of Directors is in the view that the revenue will continue to grow with the SD WiFi enable chip as the main revenue driver in the next half year but may be restricted by the weakening of Europe economies or others unforeseen external factor.

18. Profit Forecast and Profit Guarantee

The Company did not announce any profit guarantee to date.

19. Taxation

The company has been awarded MSC Status and was granted the extension on pioneer status, which exempts 100% of the statutory business income from taxation for a period of 5 years commencing from its effective date on 14 April 2011. The taxation provided in the financial statements were for the interest income derived from placement of fixed deposits with licenced financial institutions.
