# PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO THE MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS ("MFRS") 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

### A1. Accounting policies and methods of computation

The interim financial statements for the current quarter are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Rule 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the latest audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2017. These explanatory notes attached to the quarterly financial report provide an explanation on events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2017.

MPay and its subsidiaries ("Group") recorded revenue of RM2.993 million in the quarter ended 30 June 2018 ("current quarter") compared with the revenue of RM1.607 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter representing an increase of RM1.386 million in the current quarter under review. The increase in revenue was due to the increase in payment services revenue.

The Group recorded Loss Before Tax of RM1.789 million during the current quarter compared to Loss Before Tax of RM2.068 million compared to preceding year corresponding quarter. The Group recorded a Loss After Tax of RM1.789 million for the current quarter under review as compared to Loss After Tax of RM2.091 million recorded in the preceding year corresponding quarter. The increase in the Loss after tax was due to the increase of depreciation and amortization expenses.

The Group cash position and liquidity remains healthy with short term fund and cash balance of about RM37.60 million. The total order book as at 30 June 2018 was RM1.769 million.

Under the current financial quarter review, the Group recorded revenue of RM2.993 million, representing a decrease in revenue of RM0.617 million as compared to RM3.610 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter. The Group recorded Loss Before Tax of RM1.789 million, representing a decrease in loss before tax of RM0.618 million as compared to RM2.407 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter.

#### 3. Prospects of the Group

MPay Group is on track to launch our QuicKredit loan services targeting both individuals and businesses by quarter three this year. The MPay's Quickash Peer-to-Peer (P2P) financing platform launched last September has successfully facilitated more than 9 business loans totaling RM9.2 million to-date. We are confident both QuicKredit direct lending and Quickash P2P lending business will contribute to both top line and bottom line of the Company in the year 2018.

On 4 July 2018, ManagePay Marketing Sdn. Bhd. ("MMSB"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company incorporated a new 80%-owned subsidiary known as ManagePay BuyMalaysia Sdn. Bhd. ("BuyMalaysia"). BuyMalaysia is to provide Business-to-Business-to-Customers (B2B2C) ecommerce platform engaged in the business of online shopping portal for sale and distribution of various products under various categories to the public at large to Malaysian as well as international customers or buyers. BuyMalaysia also provides the merchant with services like product upload, product update, marketing, logistics and customer service.
