# (a) NOTES PURSUANT TO THE FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD 134 (FRS 134): INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

## A1. Basis of reporting preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and Appendix 9B of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ACE Market Listing Requirements.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Audited Financial Statements of the Company for the FYE 31 December 2010 and the accompanying explanatory notes attached to the interim financial report.

#### FRS 101: Presentation of Financial Statements (revised)

During the financial year, the company had paid a single tier tax exempt dividend of 4 sen per share amounting to RM1,710,280 in respect of the FYE 31 December 2010 on 15 July 2011. For the preceding year's corresponding period, no dividend was paid.

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#### B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS

# B1. Review of performance

The Group achieved a revenue of RM8.084 million and a profit before taxation of RM1.457 million for the current quarter ended 30 September 2011. The decreased in revenue by approximately 3.30% compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter was due to lower orders received in the food service equipment division. However, profit before tax increased by approximately 62.06% from RM0.882 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2010 to RM1.457 million in the current quarter ended 30 September 2011. The lower profit before tax which the Group incurred in the preceding year corresponding quarter was mainly due to a one-off listing expenses.

# B2. Material changes in the current quarter's results compared to the results of the immediate preceding quarter

In the current quarter under review, the Group's revenue stood at RM8.084 million or 13.21% lower as compared to RM9.314 million that was achieved in the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2011. The decreased in revenue was mainly attributable to lower orders received in the food service equipment division in the current quarter compared to the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2011. Accordingly, profit before taxation reduced from RM1.743 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2011 to RM1.457 million in the current quarter ended 30 September 2011, representing a decrease of approximately 16.41%, due to higher selling expenses incurred in the current quarter.

## **B3.** Prospects

The Malaysian animal feed additives market is expected to have a positive outlook with an expected compound annual growth rate ("CAGR") of 5.9% from 2009 to 2014 with market size growing to RM270.8 million in 2014, whilst the Malaysian food service equipment market is also expected to grow at a CAGR of 8.3% from 2009 to 2014 with market size growing to RM434.5 million in 2014.

The Board of Directors is optimistic of the Group's prospect in the future.

#### B4. Profit forecast

No profit forecast has been issued by the Group previously in any public document.
