A1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard ("MFRSs") 134: Interim Financial Reporting in Malaysia and Appendix 9B of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Securities ("Listing Requirements"). No comparative figures for the preceding year's corresponding quarter and period are available as Pasukhas Group Berhad ("the Company") was listed on the ACE Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") on 29th August 2012.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Proforma Consolidated Financial Information and the Accountants' Report for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 and for the three (3) months financial period ended 31 March 2012 as disclosed in the Prospectus of the Company dated 2 August 2012. B. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE ACE MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA SECURITIES

B1. Review of performance

For the current financial quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM10.646 million and a profit before tax of RM1.129 million. There is no comparative figures available for the preceding year's corresponding quarter and period as the Company was listed on the ACE Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") on 29 August 2012.

However, the Group recorded an increase in overall revenue by RM3.866 million to RM10.646 million for the current financial quarter under review as compared to RM6.780 million in the preceding financial quarter. The increase in revenue was mainly attributed to the higher progress billings issued for two (2) M&E engineering services projects. In addition, the Group's revenue was derived mainly from Malaysia (96.5%) followed by Indonesia (3.0%) and UAE (0.5%).

The Group's profit before tax decreased by 13.1% to RM1.129 million for the current financial quarter under review as compared to RM1.299 million for the preceding financial quarter due to the listing expenses incurred by the Company.

The M&E engineering services segment remains as the largest contributor to the Group's revenue and segmental result with RM10.476 million and RM2.681 million respectively. These amounts constituted 98.4% of the Group's total revenue and 95.2% of the Group's total gross profit, respectively. The remaining contributor to the Group's revenue is from the manufacturing of LV switchboard segment (1.6%) while there was no contribution from the trading of equipment for the current financial quarter under review.

Revenue of the Group increased by 57.0% to RM10.646 million for the current financial quarter as compared to the preceding financial quarter mainly due to higher progress billings issued for two (2) M&E engineering services projects. The Group's profit before tax decreased by 13.1% to RM1.129 million for the current financial quarter as compared to the preceding financial quarter mainly due to the listing expenses incurred by the Company.

We believe that we will continue to enjoy positive growth and favourable prospects for the fourth quarter of the current financial year mainly due to incremental works expected to be undertaken for our contract to provide electrical works for a property development project at Ara Damansara, Selangor.
